PRESENTATION RESCHEDULED FOR NEW ULS ONLINE SERVICES, MDS AND ITFS, FROM JANUARY 28 TO FEBRUARY 11, 2004

This Notice updates and supercedes Public Notice DA 04-93. Those who pre-registered for the original event under the previous date of January 28 will automatically be registered for the new event date.

The FCC has rescheduled the presentation of MDS/ITFS from January 28, 2004 to February 11, 2004. As part of a continuing effort to improve the license application process, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (WTB) announces the upcoming conversion of Multipoint Distribution Service (MDS, including Multichannel Multipoint Distribution Service, MMDS) and Instructional Television Fixed Service (ITFS) data to the Universal Licensing System (ULS). WTB will hold a public forum about the new online capabilities on Wednesday, February 11, 2004, from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM. The demonstration will take place at the Washington, DC headquarters building, 445 Twelfth Street, S. W., in the third floor South Conference Room (Room 3-B516). WTB requests that interested parties pre-register for the event by February 10, 2004.

The WTB is in the process of updating ULS to accommodate electronic filing of simple purpose applications for ITFS and MDS, and of converting existing license and application data for access in ULS. The demonstration will include topics such as:

- Searches
- Conversion of applications and licenses
- Availability of Electronic Filing
