MEDICAL SURVEILLANCE

1. References (a) and (b) establish robust requirements for deployment medical surveillance. These requirements fall within the mission of Navy Environmental Health Center and are in consonance with your Command's initiatives for Forward Deployed Preventive Medicine Units (FD-PMUs) and casualty prevention and training for Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Environmental (CBRE) hazards.
2. You are designated Medical Program Manager for Deployment Medical Surveillance and will give this your highest priority. In this capacity and in light of the priority assigned, you are directed to review your current assets and programs and determine how best to reassign those assets in order to meet your new priorities.
3. Your responsibilities are for program development, implementation, budget formulation, funds distribution and manpower allocations as part of the budget execution process. Management of the program should be in consonance with all applicable Navy and DoD guidance.
4. Your activities regarding program development and funding shall be coordinated with Assistant Chief for Operational Medicine and Fleet Support (Med-02).
