NEW: Two more Frio County Jail escapees caught

Authorities have nabbed two of four inmates who were on the lam after an escape from the Frio County Jail in August.

Federal marshals, in conjunction with Webb County sheriff's deputies, rounded up Reymundo Flores Alaniz and Victor Nava Franco at a residence in Rio Bravo early today.

Law officers learned of their whereabouts "by a tip from a citizen due to all the media coverage," said Deputy U.S. Marshal Timothy Hughes.

"I would like to thank the good citizens of Webb County, and the fine work of both the United States Marshals Service deputies and the deputies of the Webb County Sheriff's Department in the apprehension of Alaniz and Nava Franco," LaFayette Collins, U.S. marshal for the Western District of Texas, said in a news release.

"The United States Marshals Service continues to investigate and pursue the remaining escapees and the individuals responsible for creating an environment allowing those prisoners to escape. This investigation will continue until justice is served," Collins said.

Their arrests mean three of the five inmates who escaped Aug. 6 from the privately run jail in Pearsall are back in custody.

Manuel De La Fuente, one of the escapees, turned himself in Aug. 16 at his father's house in Laredo and gave investigators information about three other suspects from San Antonio who helped them escape or harbored them after the breakout.

Flores and Nava were to have initial appearances in Laredo on Thursday, Hughes said.

Since the U.S. Marshals Service was offering \$10,000 rewards apiece for information leading to the arrests of each of the suspects, the tipster could receive \$20,000.

Still on the lam are Luis Angel Garcia Esparza and Jorge Arturo Castañeda Silva.

Marshals were expected to discuss the arrests at a news conference in San Antonio this afternoon.
