



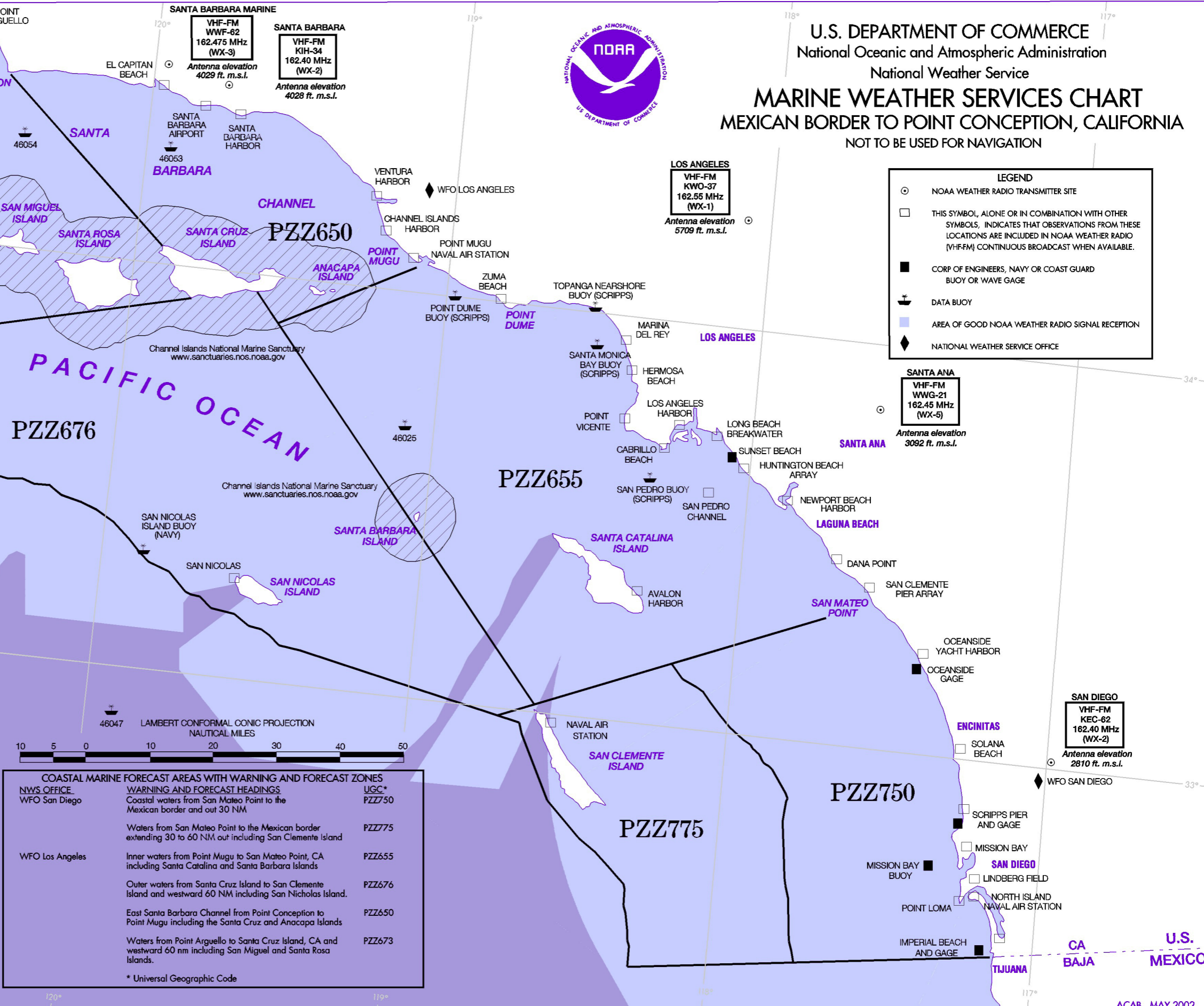

MARINE WEATHER REPORTING PROGRAM The National Weather Service (NWS) has established a nationwide Mariner Report Program - MAREP - to help improve marine warnings and forecasts...

EXPLANATION OF ADVISORIES/WARNINGS SMALL CRAFT ADVISORY: Issued to alert mariners to sustained (more than two hours) weather or sea conditions, either present or forecast, that might be hazardous to small boats...

NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE TELEPHONE NUMBERS Marine weather forecasts and also Small Craft Advisories, Gale, Storm, Hurricane Force Wind, Tropical Storm, and Hurricane Warnings, when issued, are recorded and can be obtained by telephone as follows:

NOAA WEATHER RADIO NOAA Weather Radio broadcasts can usually be received 20-40 miles from the transmitting antenna site, depending on terrain and the quality of the receiver used...

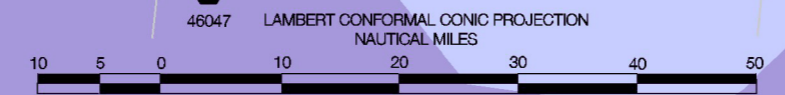
