Martha Stewart Begins Service of Sentence

On October 8, 2004, at approximately 6:15 a.m., Martha Stewart arrived at the Federal Prison Camp,

Alderson, West Virginia, for service of her sentence. Stewart was sentenced in the Southern District of

New York to a term of 5 months imprisonment for Obstruction of Justice, False Statements; and for

Conspiracy to Obstruct Justice, make False Statements, and Commit Perjury. Additionally, she was

sentenced to a two-year term of supervised release, five months of which will be served in home

confinement.

The Federal Prison Camp, Alderson, West Virginia is a minimum security facility, which houses

approximately 1050 inmates. The institution is located in the foothills of the Allegheny Mountains, 270

miles southwest of Washington, DC.
