ANNE POMERANTZ IS SELECTED AS DEPUTY REGIONAL ATTORNEY IN NLRB'S LOS ANGELES REGION 31 OFFICE

Arthur F. Rosenfeld, General Counsel of the National Labor Relations Board, today announced the selection of Anne P. Pomerantz as Deputy Regional Attorney in the National Labor Relations Board's Regional Office in Los Angeles, CA (Region 31).

A career NLRB attorney, Ms. Pomerantz joined the Agency's Special Litigation Branch in Washington, DC in 1992. She transferred to Region 31 in 1995 and in 2001 was promoted to Supervisory Attorney. Ms. Pomerantz will assist Regional Director James McDermott in the enforcement and administration of the National Labor Relations Act in the Southern California counties served by Region 31.

The National Labor Relations Act is the primary federal law that regulates labor-management relations in the private sector. In enforcing this law, the NLRB conducts secret-ballot elections to determine whether employees desire union representation and investigates, prosecutes and remedies unfair labor practices committed by employers and unions.

Commenting on her appointment, General Counsel Rosenfeld noted:

Anne is a skilled and dedicated lawyer who brings a wide range of experiences to her new position. In addition to her legal accomplishments, she has made a solid contribution to the development of the Agency's computerized case tracking system, and she has earned the respect and trust of colleagues in Washington Headquarters and in the field.

Ms. Pomerantz is a native of Old Tappan, NJ who graduated in 1983 from Washington University in St. Louis, MO. She is a 1990 graduate of the Benjamin N. Cardozo School of Law at Yeshiva University in NY and was an associate with the firm of Epstein, Becker & Green, P.C. before joining the NLRB. She and her son Jesse reside in Los Angeles.
