









What is the Animal Welfare Information Center?

The Animal Welfare Information Center (AWIC) is part of the National Agricultural Library (NAL), which is located in Beltsville, Maryland. The Center was established in December 1986 as mandated by amendments to the Animal Welfare Act. It is the focal point for those interested in obtaining information or publications covering many aspects of animal welfare. The center serves many types of users, including: laboratory technicians, veterinarians, animal care committee members, administrators, researchers, and private citizens. AWIC can help these people and others interested in learning more about methods for the humane care, use, and handling of animals in research, testing, and education.

AWIC Services

The Information Center staff combines subject expertise, state-of-the-art technology, and networking to assist users in meeting their ever-expanding needs for information. The staff can assist you in alternatives searching, finding answers to specific questions or in beginning a more extensive research program.
