SUBJECT: Revised SNF NO PAY File—Effective January 1, 2004

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **A. Background:** As part of its support of SNF consolidated billing and SNF PPS CMS has provided FI shared systems (SSs) with a SNF NO PAY File. This file, initially released November 1, 2002 for April 1, 2003 implementation, contains HCPCS codes that cannot be paid to a SNF. As a result of changes in HCPCS for 2004, this update is necessary.
- **B. Policy:** As part of the implementing legislation for SNF PPS, the Balanced Budget Act of 1997 requires that all Part B services provided to SNF residents be paid on any existing fee schedule. Additionally, there are certain services that should not be paid to SNFs. The HCPCS codes for these services are provided to FIs annually, with quarterly updates as necessary.
- **C. Provider Education:** FIs shall inform affected providers by posting this document and the related Excel file on their Web site within 2 weeks. If they have a listserv that targets affected providers, they shall use it to notify subscribers that an updated SNF NO PAY File is available on their Web site.
