

# 12 FAH-3 H-420 FIREARMS QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

## 12 FAH-3 H-421 REQUIREMENTS

*(TL:FOMH-1; 12-4-95)*

Special agents must meet the following requirements for qualification:

(1) **Weapons Qualification.** DS requires that special agents meet or exceed specified minimum scores:

(a) DS-authorized handgun (except Ruger SP101)—240/300,

(b) Ruger SP101 revolver—200/250,

(c) Shotgun: #4 buckshot—150/270 pellets on target slug—8/10 on target, and

(d) Uzi submachine gun—60/70;

(2) **Frequency.** Agents serving domestically, who are authorized by their assignments to carry weapons on a daily basis, must qualify every four (4) months with a handgun, shotgun, and submachine gun.

## 12 FAH-3 H-422 NOTIFICATION OF AGENT QUALIFICATION SCORES

*(TL:FOMH-1; 12-4-95)*

Agents are responsible for advising their supervisors of their weapons qualifications scores. The firearms officer must submit individual agents' qualification scores on Range Qualification Forms and forward them to the DS Registrar in the Training Center:

## **12 FAH-3 H-423 SAC RESPONSIBILITY CONCERNING AGENT QUALIFICATION**

*(TL:FOMH-1; 12-4-95)*

The SAC for each field office is responsible for ensuring that each agent under his or her supervision is qualified or, in lieu of qualification, that the appropriate documents are forwarded to the Diplomatic Security Training Center, Registrar's Office (DS/EX/PLD/TSD) specifying the reason for non-qualification and waivers obtained, when applicable.

## **12 FAH-3 H-424 WAIVERS**

*(TL:FOMH-1; 12-4-95)*

a. Special agents who are unable to satisfy qualification requirements must submit a request for a waiver to the SAC, who will then forward the request to the Director of the Diplomatic Security Service (DS/DSS).

b. The Director of the Diplomatic Security Service (DS/DSS) reviews all requests for waivers, and approves or denies them.

c. DS/DSS reviews these waivers on an annual basis.
