

## **12 FAH-3 H-440 WEAPONS REPAIR AND FIRING RANGE**

### **12 FAH-3 H-441 WEAPONS REPAIR**

*(TL:FOMH-1; 12-4-95)*

a. The Bureau of Diplomatic Security Weapons Program Officer (DS/PSD/PE) will make any necessary repairs to Department firearms issued in the United States. Repair of personally-owned weapons is the responsibility of the owner. Any repairs to Department-approved personally-owned weapons must, however, be re-inspected by the DS weapons program officer prior to reuse.

b. The firearms officer will unload and ship both Department weapons requiring repair and inspections and personally-owned weapons which have been repaired and need re-inspection via United Parcel Service (UPS) insured to:

### **12 FAH-3 H-442 FIRING RANGE**

*(TL:FOMH-1; 12-4-95)*

a. SACs are responsible for obtaining a local firing range to be used by their agents for weapons qualifications purposes. SACs will attempt to reach agreements with local, state or other Federal authorities for use of their range facilities. If such efforts are not successful, SACs will contact GSA to arrange use of a nearby Federal Protective Service range.

b. The range should have capability to accommodate three (3), seven (7), fifteen (15), and twenty-five (25) yard target settings in order to shoot the distances required in the Diplomatic Security Service qualification course. The range must also have facilities for firing DS-support weapons for qualification.

c. The SACs will determine the annual cost for use of the range and submit a support request form to DS/DSS/FLD for approval. (See sections 12 FAH-3 H-113 and 12 FAH-3 H-114 .)
