It is important that the proper standardized format be followed in transmitting direct relay telegrams on welfare and whereabouts matters in order to facilitate retransmission via commercial facilities without retyping and with a minimum of review. For more detailed information, see introductory chapter, section 7 FAM 035.

The sample Direct Relay telegrams shown in Exhibits 7 FAM 171 Exhibit 171 and 7 FAM 172 Exhibit 172 are typical of overseas citizens-oriented cases with which a post is most likely to become involved. The text of these sample messages, although recommended, are not mandatory unless otherwise stated.

7 FAM 171 WELFARE AND WHEREABOUTS RESPONSE

See 7 FAM 171 Exhibit 171 for a sample of a basic response to an inquiry which concerned parents have addressed to the Embassy of Consulate, either through the Department or directly. Note the phrase "ask you be advised" in the text of this message, which automatically indicates that the necessary Privacy Act authorization has been obtained.

7 FAM 172 INTERIM WELFARE AND WHEREABOUTS REPORT

Interim reports, although negative in nature, reassure concerned family or friends in the United States that a search for a missing person is in progress (see 7 FAM 172 Exhibit 172). Reasonably timed interim reports may also forestall increased inquiries or other pressures on the Department or post.
