Carriers may be reluctant of the requirement to create a data base for reporting because of the additional time this will take from call center staff. The inquiry should already be tracked in the Carrier's claims processing system and the duplication of efforts is a foreseeable concern. However, CMS may not be able to obtain detailed information on why hard copy MPFS are being requested, or multiple CDs, par decision impact, or who has already received a complimentary hardcopy MPFS and who has not if a database isn't established. Addresses and provider numbers were captured in the NAS CD-ROM Inquiry database for mailing and tracking purposes.

Attachment I - Bulletin Article Delivery Mechanism Announcement for 2003 MPFS

This applies to the following states: Alaska, Arizona, Colorado, Hawaii, Iowa, Nevada, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Washington and Wyoming.

Each November, Noridian sends a Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (MPFS), also known as a Disclosure Report, to the Medicare Part B provider community. The fee schedule will contain pricing for procedures as well as other information physicians will need for billing Medicare in the calendar year 2003. This year, Noridian requested from CMS and was approved to produce the MPFS on CD rather than hardcopy. More information on this pilot project has been included on page 3 of this bulletin.

If your facility is in need of more than one copy, you are required to either replicate the CD that is mailed to your office, download a copy from the Publication section of our Website: www.noridianmedicare.com, or purchase a copy using the Medicare Physician Fee Schedule Request Form on page 7 of this bulletin.

Note: Do **not** complete the attached form if you are a provider who has not yet received your fee schedule after the November 16th mailing. Contact Noridian's Provider Enrollment department to determine that Noridian has your correct address on file. All fee schedules that are returned due to undeliverable addresses are tracked by Provider Enrollment for the purpose of obtaining the correct provider mailing information.

If you are not a Medicare provider and you currently receive "Medicare B News" by paying a subscription fee, please be aware that the MPFS is not included with your bulletin subscription fee. Noridian encourages you to download a copy from our web site, www.noridianmedicare.com or purchase the number of copies your office will need using the form mentioned above.

Note: When using the adjacent form to order additional fee schedules, please ensure you have listed a complete mailing address, contact name and telephone number. You must also indicate which state fee schedule you are requesting. A check made out to "NAS LLC" must be enclosed with the completed Medicare Physician Fee Schedule Request Form.

For the states of Washington and Oregon, there are two separate MPFSs for your state. You must indicate which locality you wish to receive. Locality information is as follows:

- Oregon Locality 01: Washington, Clackamas and Multnomah County
- Oregon Locality 99: Remainder of Oregon
- Washington Locality 02: King County, Washington
- Washington Locality 99: Remainder of Washington

Societies and organizations including medical associations, congressional offices, Medicaid, CMS, Quality Improvement Organizations, etc. can receive one complimentary copy of the MPFS. However, a written request on your organization's letterhead accompanying the completed request form is required along with a notation as to your office preference: CD or hardcopy MPFS.

2003 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule Update and Participation Enrollment Process

Dear Bob,

This email is to inform you that CMS has released guidance to Medicare contractors on the 2003 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (MPFS) per CMS Change Request 2486, Transmittal AB-02-181. The finalized MPFS regulation was published on December 31, 2002 with a March 1, 2003 effective date.

Accordingly, Noridian Administrative Services (NAS) has begun mailing CDs containing the 2003 MPFS, Medicare participation enrollment process and relevant information to physicians, suppliers and other Part B providers. A CD is also being sent to you.

CMS has asked NAS to make you aware of current developments related to the 2003 MPFS via Attachment 2 to CR 2486. I am including this CMS document as an attachment to this email for your convenience. This attachment is important because it contains details including CMS instructions regarding claims payment, participation enrollment periods and the use of 2003 HCPCS codes.

CY 2003 Physician Fee Schedule Implementation

The Physician Fee Schedule (PFS) regulation was published on or about December 31, 2002, with a March 1, 2003, effective date. Unfortunately, under current law, the 2003 fee schedule includes a negative update. This negative update reflects a defect in the statutory formula for computing the sustainable growth rate, which has been affected by unanticipated changes in economic conditions. Regrettably, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services does not have the legal authority to correct this flaw. The Administration has worked with Congress throughout 2002 to correct the provision of law, which results in the reduction in physician payments. The Administration will continue to work with Congress to make changes that could have a positive impact on physician payments in the coming

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years. Given this commitment, we hope that physicians/practitioners will choose to participate in the Medicare program in 2003, and into the future.

Since the publication of the final regulation was delayed past November 1, 2002, implementation plans for the CY 2003 PFS have been modified. Specifically:

- The participation enrollment period will commence on January 9, 2003, and run through February 28, 2003. The material will be released by the Part B carriers on or about January 2, 2003 to ensure delivery by January 9. Physicians/practitioners will have until February 28, 2003 to make their participation decision. Please note that this enrollment period differs from what you will see in mailed materials. This is because the enrollment materials were printed before this change.
- The CY 2003 payment rates for physician/practitioner services will be effective March 1, 2003.
- Claims for physician/practitioner services in January and February 2003 that are <u>processed</u> before March 1, 2003 will be paid at the <u>CY 2002 payment rates.</u>
- Claims for physician/practitioner services in January and February 2003 that cannot be processed before February 28, 2003, will be paid at the <u>CY 2003 payment rates</u>. Therefore, physicians/practitioners are encouraged to submit January and February claims to their carriers as quickly as possible.
 - Beginning in July 2003, MPFS services with January and February 2003 dates of service and with 2002 HCPCS will be processed and paid at the 2002 rates. MPFS services for January and February 2003 services paid at the 2003 rates (because they were processed March 1, 2003 or later), will be automatically adjusted by Medicare carriers in July 2003. These automatic adjustments will pay the difference between what was paid and what should have been paid for January and February 2003 MPFS services based on the 2002 rates. Physicians/practitioners will be reminded about this change for July 2003 in a subsequent announcement. Further information on adjustments for changes in participation status will be forthcoming.
- Physicians/practitioners are encouraged not to use the new CY 2003 HCPCS codes for MPFS services performed during the months of January and February 2003. Those services should be submitted with the HCPCS codes used to bill them during CY 2002. If the new HCPCS codes are submitted before March 1, 2003, carriers will hold claims until March 1, 2003 and then pay the code at the 2003 rate.
 - (Note that fiscal intermediaries will return claims to providers for services performed in January and February 2003 that contain new 2003 HCPCS codes that are payable on the physician fee schedule. Providers are encouraged to use the HCPCS previously used in CY2002 to bill for the service furnished.)
- Physicians/practitioners should bill January and February 2003 services separately from services
 for other time periods. In addition, if a January or February 2003 service must be billed with a
 new HCPCS, it should be billed on a separate claim so that other services, with 2002 HCPCS,
 will not be held.

Noridian Administrative Services (NAS) requested from CMS and was approved to produce the 2003 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (MPFS) Disclosure Report using a Compact Disc (CD). The purpose in using the CD delivery method instead of printed copies is to offer information more timely with the availability of being widely shared within each office in a mode that can be printed, analyzed and more easily integrated with computer software.

NAS, in working with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Central and Regional Offices, has worked within the following timeline to prepare for the mailing of the MPFS:

Fee schedules for each of NAS' eleven contracted states will be displayed in state-specific arrangements to allow the information to be easily identified by state/locality. Three formats are offered, each containing the same information per state, to accommodate how providers will want to view the data, print the data ant to allow for integration within various provider computer systems.

- CSV The Comma Separated Value (CSV) format is best used to download MPFS information on computer systems. NAS recommends that the CSV format be viewed by system support and/or your billing companies to assist with loading into your computer system.
- HTML- The HTML format allow for quick searches and ease in viewing the MPFS information.
- PDF A Portable Document Format (PDF) file is supplied in a readable format. Providers are encouraged to print using this file format option if a hardcopy is needed in your office. The printed PDF will have the same appearance as previously mailed hardcopy MPFS Disclosure Reports.

The CD can be used on any computer system that is Windows 95 or newer, which comes with a web browser, and includes a CD drive. (Note: a web browser is a component within your computer that allows for interaction with the World Wide Web.) Internet connectivity is NOT needed to use this CD. Although Website links are often offered in the supplemental NAS information on the CD, Internet is **not** required for any of the MPFS information nor the majority of NAS supplemental information. A

letter with instructions on how to use the disc and the toll free telephone number for CD usage assistance and requests for a hardcopy MPFS will be included with the CD.

The CD will include the 2003 MPFS Disclosure Reports, Medicare Participation Agreement and Fact Sheet. Related Information such as MPFS Indicator Listings, Bundled Codes, Excluded Codes, Endoscopy Families, Noncovered "N" Codes, Invalid Codes and Deleted Codes will also be included within the 2003 MPFS Section of the CD. To assist your office staff, we have included Medicare instructions regarding Electronic Data Interchange (EDI), HIPAA, Provider Enrollment, and a large amount of educational material including the newest Medicare B News bulletin, claim submission instructions, billing manuals and Advanced Beneficiary Notice (ABN) requirements. Providers are encouraged to replicate the information for their staff working with Medicare.

For providers without access to a CD drive, the 2003 MPFS information can be requested from trained representatives at a newly created toll free telephone number, 1-800-933-0614. The trained representatives will be able to answer questions you may have on this project or who require technical assistance between the hours of 8:30 a.m to 6:00 p.m Central Time.

NAS will continue to utilize the Website as our primary avenue of communicating updates. As quarterly updates or changes occur, NAS will make those updates available on the Provider Service homepage of our web site, www.noridianmedicare.com, as well as through our Medicare B News bulletin.

The copyright notice is: CPT codes, descriptors and other data only are copyright 1999 American Medical Association (or such other date of publication of CPT). All Rights Reserved. Applicable FARS/DFARS apply.

NOTE: For your information FARS/DFARS is defined as FARS—Federal Acquisition Regulation System and DFARS—Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement.

B. Point and Click License

In addition, you must use a point and click license (a license that appears on a computer screen or Web page and includes a computer program or Web page mechanism that requires users to indicate whether they accept the terms of the license by pointing their cursor and clicking that they accept the terms of the license prior to accessing a document containing CPT). Whenever Publications containing CPT are used on the Internet, an end user agreement in the form of a point and click license is required. (See Attachment IV.) It is your option to use a point and click license prior to each document containing CPT codes, or before initial access to any pages containing CPT codes at your Web site section level. 


