Your efforts to curb the problem of unsolicited bulk email may damage legitimate businesses.

I am concerned about the proposed requirement for merchants to maintain suppression lists, and under force of law require all the people we do business with to use these lists.

As a small business person, with few resources to deal with the huge array of requirements already in place, every additional hoop government makes us jump through makes it more difficult to survive.
