- The Navy, DLA and DCAA are responsible for management and further distribution of the target hours ceiling under their control.
- The DoD/NASA agreement requires that reimbursements earned be monitored to determine if they are in line with annual hourly targets. Each DoD Component is to review billings at least quarterly and report any significant deviations from its assigned hourly target. DoD Components are to stay within established target ceilings. There is no requirement for reimbursement by the NASA if DoD exceeds the terms of the agreement without prior NASA approval.
