Item 1 Enter the name of the licensee.

<u>Item 2</u> This item is mandatory. You must enter the licensee/assignor's ten-digit FCC Registration Number (FRN) assigned by the Commission Registration System (CORES). The FRN is a unique entity identifier for everyone doing business with the Commission. ### 9) CONDITIONS OF GRANT

Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934.
- This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.
