Instructions for Schedule for New Lease FCC Form 603-T, Schedule B

Schedule B is a supplementary schedule that is used to provide information regarding new Leases. Each Call Sign listed on the Main Form requires a separate Schedule B.

Item 1 Enter the Call Sign of the station that is to be included in the Lease.

Item 2a If the filing is for a Spectrum Manager Lease, indicate whether the lease is more than one year or one year or less.

<u>Item 2b</u> If the filing is for a *De Facto* Transfer Lease, indicate whether the lease is Long-Term (more than 360 days) or Short-Term (no longer than 180 days, renewable up to 360 days).

<u>Item 2c</u> This item only applies to *De Facto* Transfer Leases. Enter 'Y' if the filing is for "conversion" of a Short-Term *De Facto* Transfer Lease into a Long-Term *De Facto* Transfer Lease. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.9035(h). Otherwise, enter 'N'.

Item 2d If the response to item 2c is 'N', the Licensee must answer the question indicated.

Item 3a Provide the date the Lease is due to commence.

Item 3b Provide the date the Lease is due to expire.

<u>Item 4</u> For geographically-licensed services, check Item 4 if the Lease encompasses only a portion of the licensed spectrum or licensed geographic area. If Item 4 is checked, complete Schedule F and, if applicable, Schedule G.

<u>Item 5a</u> If the Lease involves Cellular Radiotelephone, broadband PCS, or Specialized Mobile Radio (SMR) spectrum, enter 'Y'. If the response to 5a is 'Y', complete 5b and 5c.

Item 5b If the Lessee holds a 10 percent or greater direct or indirect interest in any entity that has access (through license authorizations, Leases, or Subleases) to 10 MHz or more of Cellular Radiotelephone, broadband PCS, or SMR spectrum in a geographic area or market, enter 'Y'. Otherwise, enter 'N'. If the response to this Item is 'Y', in an attachment, specify all geographic areas/markets (e.g., BTA, MSA, county, etc.) where there are spectrum overlaps and the total amount of spectrum that the Lessee will hold and/or lease in each geographic area/market. If the Lessee or any of the Lessee's affiliates have pending Applications/Notifications to acquire leased/subleased spectrum on file with the Commission and if this spectrum is in the same geographic area(s)/market(s) as the spectrum that is the subject of this Application/Notification, include the spectrum in the pending Applications/Notifications in the list of geographic areas/markets where there are spectrum overlaps and in the total amount of spectrum that the Lessee will hold and/or Lease/Sublease in each geographic area/market. Also provide in an attachment the competitors that are providing service in each geographic area/market.

<u>Item 5c</u> If the response to Item 5b is 'Y' and if the Lease will result in the loss of one or more service provider(s)/competitor(s) in any of the overlap geographic areas/markets, enter 'Y'.

Item 6a Indicate the type(s) of radio service offerings the Lessee plans to provide.

All entities that are telecommunications carriers should select common carrier on this form. The term 'telecommunications carrier' means any provider of telecommunications services, except that such term does not include aggregators of telecommunications services (the term 'aggregator' means any person that, in the ordinary course of its operations, makes telephones available to the public or to transient users of its premises, for interstate telephone calls using a provider of operator services). A telecommunications carrier shall be treated as a common carrier under the Communications Act and the Commission's rules (*i.e.*, as an entity that holds

itself out for hire indiscriminately, in interstate or foreign communications by wire or radio, or in interstate or foreign radio transmission of energy, for the purpose of carrying transmissions provided by the customer), only to the extent that it is engaged in providing telecommunications services.

The term 'telecommunications service' means the offering of telecommunications (*i.e.*, the transmission, between or among points specified by the user, of information of the user's choosing, without change in the form or content of the information as sent and received) for a fee directly to the public, or to such classes of users as to be effectively available directly to the public, regardless of the facilities used.

Non-common carriers do not hold themselves out indiscriminately for hire as carriers of communications provided by the customer. A person engaged in radio broadcasting shall not, insofar as such person is so engaged, be deemed a common carrier. Thus, those entities meeting this definition would select non-common carrier for this item.

Private internal users are those entities that utilize telecommunications services purely for internal business purposes or public safety communications and not on a for hire or for profit basis. Such entities should select 'Private' for this item.

The term 'Broadcast Services' shall have the same meaning as that for "broadcasting" in § 3(6) of the Communications Act of 1934, *i.e.*, the dissemination of radio communications intended to be received by the public, directly or by the intermediary of relay stations." 47 U.S.C. 153(6). Entities meeting this definition should select 'Broadcast Services' for this item.

Item 6b If the response to 6a differs from that of the Licensee with regard to its License authorization, enter 'Y'. Otherwise, enter 'N'.

Item 7a Indicate the type(s) of radio services that the Lessee plans to provide.

Item 7b If the response to 7a differs from that of the Licensee with regard to its License authorization, enter 'Y'. Otherwise, enter 'N'.

<u>Item 8a</u> Indicate whether the Lessee plans to provide interconnected service to the public switched telephone network as defined in the FCC rules. Enter 'Y' if yes. Otherwise, enter 'N'.

Item 8b If the response to 8a differs from that of the Licensee with regards to its License authorization, enter 'Y'. Otherwise, enter 'N'.
