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INSTRUCTIONS

FCC 701 is to be used when applying for additional time to construct a radio station under 47 CFR Parts 21, 23 and 25.

- A. A processing fee may be required with this application. Please refer to the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau Fee Filing Guide for information. Certain applications may request action with respect to more than one station, license, frequency or party and can be submitted together with one check if they meet specific conditions.
- B. Submit an original and one copy. The proper mailing address can be found in either the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau Fee Filing Guide or call the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau at (717) 338-2888 or 888-CALLFCC (888-225-5322) and select option #2.
- C. The name of the applicant (Item 1) must be stated as it appears on the construction authorization.
- D. Enter the applicant's ten-digit FCC Registration Number (FRN) (Item 6) assigned by the Commission Registration System (CORES). The FRN is a unique entity identifier for everyone doing business with the Commission and is mandatory effective December 3, 2001. The FRN can be obtained electronically through the FCC webpage at <https://www.fcc.gov> (click on Commission Registration System) or by manually submitting FCC Form 160.
