## ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON DIVERSITY FOR COMMUNICATIONS IN THE DIGITAL AGE MAKES RECOMMENDATIONS

Washington, D.C. – The Advisory Committee on Diversity for Communications in the Digital Age held its fourth meeting on Monday, October 4, 2004. During the meeting, the Committee adopted two resolutions.

The first resolution "strongly urges the Commission to maintain effective Designated Entity rules to increase opportunities for small and minority and women owned businesses."

The second resolution urges the Commission to explore "possible ways to foster ownership diversity in the commercial FM radio band."
