End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) Disease Management Demonstration Application Process Guidelines

- Applications are due October 2, 2003.
- Use the Medicare Waiver Demonstration Application which may be found on our demonstration website: www.cms.hhs.gov/healthplans/research/esrd_demo.asp.
- Follow the outline from the Medicare Waiver Demonstration Application and address all items described in the Evaluation Criteria in the June 4, 2003 *Federal Register* notice.
- An unbound original and 2 copies plus an electronic copy of the application must be submitted; however, applicants may, but are not required to, submit 10 copies.
- Applications should be typed for clarity and should not exceed 40 double-spaced pages, exclusive of the cover letter, executive summary, forms and supporting documentation.

- 2. Technical Approach (40 points)
- 3. Financial and Organizational Capability (35 points)
- 4. Capability for Quality Assessment and Improvement (15 points)
