SUBJECT: Request for Input from Tree, Vine, and Bush Crops Producer Groups

BACKGROUND:

The Risk Management Agency (RMA) intends to obtain input from producer groups before entering into contracts for research and development to increase participation in areas or for commodities that may be underserved by the Federal crop insurance program. RMA believes this input is critical in determining the need and direction of research and potential development.

ACTION:

RMA requests input from groups or individuals representing producers of crops grown on trees, vines, and bushes so that their needs, concerns, and other input may be considered before it enters into a contract for the research and possible development of a tree, vine, and bush replacement program for growers of grapes, citrus, tree fruit and nuts, kiwi, blueberries, and other high-value, permanent (perennial) crops. Of particular interest is any input that would help RMA determine producers= interest in such a risk management program, as well as specific suggestions and concerns regarding the structure, scope, and limitations of such a program.
