Commercial Activities Inventory: Report to Congress and Release to the

Public

In your letter dated May 7, 2004, the Treasury Department withdrew from the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) the Internal Revenue Service portion of Treasury's 2003 Federal Activities Inventory Reform Act of 1998 (the FAIR Act) Commercial Activities and Inherently Governmental Activities Inventory and submitted a revised version of the Treasury inventory that includes the remaining Treasury components. This memorandum therefore supersedes my September 25, 2003, letter to Teresa Mullett Ressel on Treasury's Commercial Activities Inventory.

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has completed the review and consultation process for your Year 2003 Commercial Activities Inventory (as revised by your May 7, 2004, letter) as required by the FAIR Act. Under the Act, OMB is required to publish a notice in the Federal Register indicating that the inventory of non-inherently governmental (commercial) activities is available to the public from the agency. My staff has informed me that you are prepared to have your inventory publicly available when, as required by the Act, OMB's notice-of-availability is published in the Federal Register.

OMB has also completed the review and consultation process for your revised Year 2003 Inherently Governmental Activities Inventory as revised by your May 7, 2004, letter. As noted in the Office of Federal Procurement Policy Administrator's letter of March 14, 2003, agencies were asked to be prepared to release their 2003 inventory of inherently governmental activities to the public and the Congress without the need for a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. My staff has informed me that you are also prepared to have this inventory made publicly available when OMB's notice-of-availability is published in the Federal Register. OMB's Federal Register notice will indicate that this additional information will also be made available from the agency.

The inventories of inherently governmental and commercial activities will need to be available through your Washington, DC or national headquarters offices and ready for pick-up by the public, mailing, e-mailing or FAXing, and posted on your web site on the date of the Federal Register notice. Phone numbers of individuals who can enswer questions regarding the

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inventories will also need to be provided to OMB for publication in the Federal Register notice. You must then transmit a copy of the commercial activities inventory to Congress. The date of publication of OMB's Federal Register notice marks the start of the statutory 30-day interested party challenge process permitted under the Act. Guidance on this aspect of the FAIR Act and additional agency responsibilities are specified in OMB Circular No. A-76, as revised on May 29, 2003.
