# R2001-1 Omnibus Rate Case Proposal 

## Rates and Fees Will Not Increase Before September 2002

## Why Rates Increase

Postal costs go up like those of any other business or household. In fact, increases in costs for fuel and health benefits greatly affect the Postal Service. In addition, we are adding 1.6 million deliveries each year. The Postal Service receives no tax dollars for operations and relies solely on the sale of its products and services to cover its operating costs.

## How Rates Are Set

Many Americans perceive that the U.S. Postal Service raises rates more frequently than it does, and without regard to customers' concerns and input. The facts are quite different.

The Postal Service does not set rates unilaterally. The Postal Reorganization Act of 1970 shifted ratemaking authority from Congress to two presidentially appointed bodies: the Postal Service Governors and the Postal Rate Commission (PRC).

When the Postal Service determines that its revenues are insufficient to cover costs, it requests a

recommended decision from the independent PRC, which holds public hearings on the request.

During the hearings, interested parties-Postal Service customers, competitors, mailing groups, and members of the public-have the opportunity to provide evidence and arguments to the PRC reflecting their respective concerns.

From the time the Governors file the case, the PRC has up to 10

months to conduct in-depth hearings before it submits a recommended decision to the Governors, who act on the recommendations. The Governors may implement new rates as recommended, or implement and seek a reconsideration of the rates by the Commission, or reject the decision.

The sheer magnitude of the rate process is overwhelming. It took a two-and-a-half ton truck, filled with over 100,000 pieces of paper, just to file the last case on January 12, 2000. Testimony was submitted by 120 Postal Service and private party witnesses during 40 days of hearings before the independent PRC. A total of 78 parties, ranging from loyal customers to tough competitors, were involved in the case. Typically, the entire process of raising rates takes about a year and a half from the development of Postal Service proposals to implementation.

## Overview

In general, increases for the various product lines fall close to the average system-wide increase. As a result, the increase is fairly shared by almost all customers. This differs from some past rate cases when the increases by class were farther apart. Still, the relatively modest rate variances do reflect the cost trends. For instance, increases for letter-shaped items, particularly First-Class Mail and Standard Mail, are generally lower, reflecting the success of the letter automation program. At the same time, costs have increased more rapidly for Periodicals and Priority Mail. The slightly larger-than-average increases for these classifications reflect larger changes in costs, as the Postal Service works to improve service for these products.

Almost all products have some structural rate design changes, as discussed later. However, several are worth highlighting. For instance, there are several changes designed to foster improvements in the sorting and transportation of Periodicals. The

Postal Service will continue to refine the options for customer preparation of letter mail to provide customers more choices and improve efficiency.
Several special services, particularly certified mail and return receipts, are being refined with electronic features.

## First-Class Mail

First-Class Mail is matter that is wholly or partially in handwriting or typewriting, or that has the character of actual and personal correspondence. Any matter eligible for mailing may, at the option of the mailer, be mailed as First-Class Mail. FirstClass Mail is sealed against inspection and can include bills, statements of account, letters, and cards.

Overall, First-Class Mail rates are proposed to increase an average of 8.2 percent, which is below the average for all proposed rates.

## Proposed Increase for Single-Piece Mail Below Average

The single-piece First-Class Mail rate is proposed to increase from 34
cents to 37 cents, and the basic card rate from 21 cents to 23 cents. Singlepiece rates are proposed to increase 7.5 percent.

## No Increase for the Single-Piece Additional-Ounce Rate

The proposal calls for no change in the additional-ounce rate for singlepiece First-Class Mail.

## Decrease for the Workshare Additional-Ounce Rate

We recognize the importance of workshare mail and are proposing a half-cent decrease in the additionalounce rate.

## Larger Discounts for Automation

Under the proposal, commercial customers will see larger automation presort discounts (3- and 5-digit). The Carrier Route Automation letter discount and the Nonautomation Presort letter discount are proposed to remain at their current levels. The proposed increase in automation discounts and the proposed half-cent reduction in the workshare additionalounce rate would result in more
attractive workshare incentives, especially for bulk First-Class Mail users who mail heavier pieces.

## New Nonmachinable Letter Surcharge Reflects Cost

The current definition of nonstandard mail is being expanded to

include some letters containing objects or having other characteristics that render the pieces nonmachinable and require higher-cost manual processing. Also included in this expanded definition are mailings for which the customer requests manual processing. The nonmachinable (formerly "nonstandard") surcharge is proposed to increase from 11 cents to 12 cents for single-piece letters and from 5 cents to 5.5 cents for presorted letters and flats; this would be the first surcharge increase since 1995.

## Additional Presort Levels to Reward Finer Preparation

Two new presort levels would replace the current Basic Automation rate: Automated Area Distribution Center (AADC) and Mixed AADC. These levels encourage finer sortation by mailers when the necessary volume exists. In addition, the 3 -digit automation sort would become optional.

## Delivery and Signature Confirmation for First-Class Parcels

Currently, Delivery Confirmation and Signature Confirmation are available only for Priority Mail and Package Services. The proposal calls for making the services available for FirstClass Mail parcels.

## Business Reply Mail Fee Changes

Business reply mail continues to offer a convenient, customer-friendly solution for recipients to send FirstClass Mail and Priority Mail back to companies without prepaying postage.

Overall, business reply mail fees would increase an average of 19.8 percent.

The cost for a 1-ounce high-volume Qualified Business Reply Mail letter including postage and per piece charge would increase from 32 cents to 35.3 cents. For low-volume Qualified Business Reply Mail the cost would increase from 36 cents to 40.5 cents. For high-volume regular business reply mail the cost would increase from 44 cents to 47 cents. For regular basic business reply mail the cost would increase from 69 cents to 97 cents.

## Priority Mail

Priority Mail is defined as FirstClass Mail weighing more than 13 ounces and, at the mailer's option, any other matter (including regular First-Class Mail) weighing 13 ounces or less. Priority Mail consists of a variety of items, from lightweight documents to heavier merchandise.

## Flat-Rate Envelope Priced at 1-Pound Rate

Currently, the Priority Mail flat rate is the same as the 2-pound rate. Under this new proposal, the flat-rate envelope would be priced at the 1-pound rate. The proposed rates represent a decrease for mailers who use the flat-rate envelope, from $\$ 3.95$ to $\$ 3.85$. This includes many items weighing less than a pound, which account for the majority of flat-rate mailings.

Two- to Five-Pound Rates Are Zoned
The proposal also calls for a shift to zoned rates for weight-rated Priority Mail items weighing more than 1 pound and up to 5 pounds. The zone-based pricing would more accurately reflect costs.

This proposal would result in no change (or a decrease in rates) for items traveling shorter distances and an increase in rates for more distant items.

## Proposed Rate Changes Reflect Increasing Costs

As with all classes of mail, Priority Mail rates must cover the increasing costs associated with processing, transportation, and delivery. Overall, Priority Mail rates are proposed to increase a higher-than-average 13.5 percent.

## Pickup Fee Increases

The proposal also calls for the pickup fee for Priority Mail to increase from $\$ 10.25$ to $\$ 12.50$.

## Express Mail

Express Mail is a premium service offering guaranteed next-day and second-day delivery nationwide. The current service options are:

- Next Day and Second Day Post Office to Addressee service
- Next Day and Second Day Post Office to Post Office service
- Custom Designed Service
- Express Mail Military service


## Easy-to-Use Express Mail Rate Structure Retained

The rate proposal retains the simple, easy-to-use rate structure for Express Mail service. However, as with all classes of mail, Express Mail rates must cover the increasing costs associated with processing, transportation, and delivery.

Highlights of the proposed rate changes include an average overall increase of 9.4 percent, with increases ranging from 3.5 to 13.8 percent. The overall average percentage increase matches the proposed increase for the most commonly used Express Mail service option-Post Office to Addressee.

The lowest proposed increase percentage is reflected in the Post Office to Post Office half-pound rate, while the highest increase percentage is proposed for the Custom Designed half-pound rate.

## Flat-Rate Envelope Priced at HalfPound Rate

The most significant change proposed to the Express Mail rate structure is to price the flat-rate envelope at the half-pound rate. This would reduce the cost of using the flatrate envelope to $\$ 13.65$.

## Proposed Indemnity Reduction

 Aligns With Industry StandardUnder the proposal, the indemnity included in the base price would be reduced from $\$ 500$ to $\$ 100$. This adjustment is intended to more closely align with industry practice.

## Pickup Fee Increases

The proposal also calls for the pickup fee for Express Mail to increase from $\$ 10.25$ to $\$ 12.50$.

## Periodicals

Periodicals mail consists of a wide range of periodical publicationsprincipally magazines, newspapers, newsletters, and bulletins. To mail at Periodicals rates, each publication must be authorized by the U.S. Postal Service. Periodicals mail consists of two subclasses-Outside-County and In-County.

Overall, Periodicals rates are proposed to increase 10.0 percent. Outside-County rates would increase 10.4 percent; In-County newspapers would increase 1.7 percent.

## Outside-County

## New Nonadvertising <br> Dropship Discounts

Separate nonadvertising pound rate discounts are proposed for destination delivery unit (DDU), destination sectional center facility (DSCF), and destination area distribution center
(DADC) entry. The nonadvertising pound rate for zones $1 \& 2$ through zone 8 would remain a uniform rate.

## New Dropship Discount

The proposal calls for a discount for mail entered at the DADC. This new DADC discount will provide a dropship incentive to customers who are unable to enter their mail at sectional center facilities or delivery units.

## DSCF Dropship Eligibility Changed

The DSCF discount would remain at the current level. Mailers would be required to deposit Periodicals mail at the sectional center facility (currently DSCF rates are available for Periodicals deposited at any facility within the SCF service area).

## In-County

In-County piece rates would experience a modest increase. The delivery unit pound rate is proposed to decrease, and the per-piece delivery unit worksharing discount would increase slightly.

## Ride-Along Experiment

The successful Ride-Along experiment would be made permanent. The fee for the Ride-Along piece would be increased from 10 cents to 12.4 cents.

## Standard Mail

Standard Mail consists of mailable matter that is neither mailed nor required to be mailed as First-Class Mail, is not entered as Periodicals

Larger DDU Dropship Discount
There will be larger dropship discounts for mailers who enter Periodicals at the DDU.

## New Pallet Discount for NonletterSize Pieces

A per-piece pallet discount, regardless of the presort level, is proposed for nonletter-size pieces prepared in packages on pallets sorted to the DDU, SCF, or ADC.

## Larger Discounts for Automation

The barcode discount would be increased for all flats. This proposal furthers efforts to increase the automation compatibility of Periodicals.
(unless permitted or required by standard), and weighs less than 16 ounces.

Overall, Standard Mail rates are proposed to increase an average of 7.3 percent. On average, within each subclass, flats are proposed to increase more than letters.

## Regular and Nonprofit Rates

Regular rates are proposed to increase an average of 8 percent and Nonprofit rates would increase an average of 6.7 percent.

## Larger Destination Entry Discounts <br> Larger destination entry discounts for Standard Mail are proposed.

Greater discounts will provide an incentive for mailers to use their own or third-party transportation to move Standard Mail closer to the point of delivery.

## Additional Presort Levels to Reward Finer Preparation

Two new presort levels would replace the current Basic Automation rate: Automated Area Distribution Center (AADC) and Mixed AADC. These levels encourage finer sortation by mailers when the necessary volume exists.

## Heavier Pieces to be Eligible for Automation Rates

We propose that automationcompatible letters that weigh between 3.3 and 3.5 ounces receive an automation letter discount.

## New Nonmachinable Letter Surcharge Reflects Cost

Customers would experience higher prices for some letters containing objects or having other characteristics that render the pieces nonmachinable and require higher-cost manual processing. Also included in this

## Enhanced Carrier Route (ECR) and Nonprofit ECR

Commercial ECR rates are proposed to increase an average of 6.2 percent. Nonprofit ECR rates would increase an average of 6.5 percent.

Larger Destination Entry Discounts
Larger destination entry discounts for Standard Mail are proposed. Greater discounts will provide an incentive for mailers to use their own or third-party transportation to move Standard Mail closer to the point of delivery.

## Per-Piece Rates Increase

The proposal calls for all commercial and Nonprofit ECR per-piece rates to increase.

## Pound Rates Decrease

A modest 6.3 percent decrease is proposed for most ECR per-pound rates. Net increases or decreases would vary according to destination entry, weight, density tier (basic, high-density, or saturation), and shape. The Nonprofit ECR per-pound rate with no entry discount would remain at 37 cents.

## Residual Shape Surcharge to Better Reflect Handling Costs

The residual-shape surcharge would increase by 5 cents for items that are

## Additional Requirements for High-

 Density and Saturation Rate LettersThe significant change for ECR rates is the introduction of delivery point barcode and other automationcompatibility requirements for all ECR letters mailed at high density or saturation rates.

The barcode requirement would give
the Postal Service the option of merging this mail with other letters in carrier-route walk sequence. The automation-compatibility requirements would be the same as now exist for Standard Mail Regular automation letters. Pieces that do not meet automation compatibility would be charged the nonletter rate.

## Residual Shape Surcharge to Better Reflect Handling Costs

The residual-shape surcharge would increase by 5 cents for items that are prepared as parcels or are not letteror flat-sized. This would better reflect the actual cost of handling those items.

## Package Services

Package Services mail consists of mailable matter that is neither mailed nor required to be mailed as FirstClass Mail, nor entered as Periodicals (unless permitted or required by standard). There are four subclasses of Package Services: Parcel Post, Bound Printed Matter, Media Mail, and Library Mail.

## Parcel Post/Parcel Select

Overall, Parcel Post rates are proposed to increase 10 percent. Within Parcel Post, the Inter- and Intra-BMC rates would increase 17.6 percent and Parcel Select would increase by 4.8 percent, primarily due to dropship discounts and less postal handling.

## Larger Dropship Discounts

Customers will see larger dropship discounts, particularly for destination sectional center facility (DSCF) and destination delivery unit (DDU) entry. In many instances, this change will result in rate decreases for customers.

No-Fee Electronic Delivery Confirmation Service for Parcel Select<br>Electronic Delivery Confirmation service would be included as a basic feature of Parcel Select, and the fee

built into the rate. The proposal also calls for the elimination of the manual option for Parcel Select.

## Lighter Pieces Eligible for Separate 1-Pound Rate <br> Currently all parcels weighing up to 2 pounds are charged the same rate. The proposal introduces a separate 1-pound rate.

Three-Digit Nonmachinable Parcels Eligible for Special DSCF Rates

Special discounted 3-digit DSCF entry rates are proposed for nonmachinable parcels. Customers who prepare nonmachinable parcels will have an additional cost-saving option for entry of their parcels.

## Larger Presort Discounts

Customers will see larger discounts for Presorted parcels sorted to the bulk mail center and entered at the origin bulk mail center.

## Other Changes

The nonmachinable surcharge for Inter-BMC Parcel Post is proposed to increase. The Intra-BMC and DBMC Parcel Post nonmachinable surcharges would remain unchanged. The barcoded discount for all Package Services would remain at the current level.

## Bound Printed Matter

Bound Printed Matter rates are proposed to increase 9.1 percent.

## Larger Dropship Discounts

As in Parcel Select, customers will see larger dropship discounts, particularly for DSCF and DDU entry. In many instances, customers would experience little or no increase in rates for these items.

## Separate Flat and Parcel Rates Proposed

New separate rates for Bound Printed Matter flats and parcels are proposed. Compared to parcels (heavy catalogs and books) the
proposed flat rates would be lower. A barcode discount is also proposed for automation-compatible flats.

## Media Mail and Library Mail

Media Mail rates are proposed to increase 4 percent, and the proposal calls for Library Mail rates to increase by 3.3 percent.

## Lower Minimums and New Preparation Requirements

New lower minimum volume requirements and preparation based on the shape and machinability of the piece are proposed for presorted Media Mail and Library Mail. These changes would make preparation for both categories more consistent with the other subclasses.

## Small Increases for Heavier Items

Heavier items would see relatively small increases and lighter items would see larger increases to better align prices with costs.

## Special Services

Special services are enhancements that, for a fee in addition to postage, provide greater security and accountability; confirmation of mailing, delivery, and receipt; special handling; and payment and acceptance options for mail. Special services also provide delivery alternatives and secure options for sending money through the mail.

## Post Office Boxes Better Reflect Costs

The proposed post office box fee structure changes would result in an overall increase of 14.5 percent.

In some instances, post office box fees would remain the same. In most instances, the semiannual fee change amounts to less than $\$ 10$.

## Raising the Money Order Maximum <br> Postal Service money orders continue to provide a secure option for

making payments and sending money through the mail.

The proposal calls for the maximum value of money orders to increase from $\$ 700$ to $\$ 1000$, to enable use for more expensive purchases. The maximum money order value increase also aligns with the COD maximum, where money orders are frequently used as a payment mechanism.

Proposed changes would result in an average fee increase of 2.8 percent for money orders. Currently, the fee for all domestic Money Orders is $\$ 0.90$. A tiered Money Order fee structure with higher fees for highervalue Money Orders is being proposed. The first proposed tier would be from $\$ 0.01$ to $\$ 500$ at the existing $\$ 0.90$ fee. The second proposed tier, from $\$ 500.01$ to $\$ 1000$, would have a fee of $\$ 1.25$.

> New electronic options proposed for certified, registered, and return receipt.

## Electronic Options for Certified and Registered Mail

Historically, certified mail and registered mail have been paper-based services offering accountability and enhanced security for First-Class Mail and Priority Mail. Using these services also enables customers to separately purchase proof of delivery in the form of return receipts.

The proposal calls for electronic options added to certified and registered mail services, providing customers with the ability to call a tollfree number or to use the Internet to look up the delivery status of items.

The certified mail fee would increase from $\$ 2.10$ to $\$ 2.30$, and the basic registered mail fee would increase from $\$ 7.25$ to $\$ 7.50$ for the enhanced service.

## Electronic Option Available for Return Receipts

Currently, proof of delivery for letters is provided using the paper-based return receipt system. The proposal calls for providing customers a choice of electronic proof of delivery along with the conventional paper-based system. This new service offering would utilize aspects of the same technology applied in Delivery Confirmation. The new electronic return receipt fee would be $\$ 1.30$, compared to the existing $\$ 1.50$ fee. The paper-based return receipt fee would increase from $\$ 1.50$ to $\$ 1.75$.

## Delivery and Signature Confirmation for First-Class Parcels

Currently, Delivery Confirmation and

Signature Confirmation are available only for Priority Mail and Package Services. The proposal calls for making these services available for First-Class Mail parcels.

## Business Reply Mail Fee Changes

Business reply mail continues to offer a convenient, customer-friendly solution for recipients to send FirstClass Mail and Priority Mail back to companies without paying postage. Overall, business reply mail fees would increase an average of 19.8 percent. The total piece charge for high-volume Qualified Business Reply Mail would increase from 32 cents to 35.3 cents.

For low-volume Qualified Business
Reply Mail, the proposal calls for a
total piece charge that increases from 36 cents to 40.5 cents.

For regular basic business reply mail, the total piece charge applicable when items are handled individually would increase from 69 cents to 97 cents.

The total piece charge for highvolume regular business reply mail would increase from 44 cents to 47 cents.

## COD Fees Stay the Same

No increases are proposed for any of the COD fees.

## Mail Quality Corner MPTQM-Certified Mailers

The mailers listed here have been certified by the United States Postal Service.

Each has met all the standards of the Mail Preparation Total Quality Management (MPTQM) program.

Companies are added to this list when they pass a quality assurance review and deleted from the list if they fail a subsequent review.
