

Requirements for Acknowledgement of Arts Endowment Support

FY 04 Partnership Awards

State and Regional Agencies:

State Arts Agencies and Regional Arts Organizations must clearly acknowledge support from the National Endowment for the Arts in their programs and related promotional materials using the following language;

"This project is supported in part by an award from the National Endowment for the Arts, which believes that a great nation deserves great art."

If you have not already done so, please incorporate the NEA logo into your agency's publications and Web site along with acknowledgement of NEA support. You may download the logo from our website at www.arts.gov/manageaward/index.html.

State and Regional Grantee Organizations:

In addition to acknowledging the Arts Endowment in their own materials, SAAs and RAOs should do all they can to make sure their grantees recognize the role of the NEA in their materials. This will help promote a more complete appreciation of the federal role in supporting the arts in each state and region.

In these situations, the NEA logo should be used with an appropriate credit line that is phrased to fit the agency's unique circumstances. The following examples are included as models:

•	State of Arts Council and its programs is provided by the State of and the National Endowment for the Arts, a federal agency, which believes that a great nation deserves great art.
•	The Arts Council is funded by the State Legislature, other public and private sources, and the National Endowment for the Arts, which believes that a great nation deserves great art.
•	This project was supported by the Arts Commission, with funding from the State of and the National Endowment for the Arts, which believes that a great nation deserves great art.
•	This project was supported by the Arts Commission, a partner agency of the National Endowment for the Arts, which believes that a great nation deserves great art.
