Phyllis Lake Fire Declared Out

DILLON, MONT., (August 15, 2004, 5:00 pm) – The Phyllis Lake Fire, a human caused fire in

the Anaconda Pintler Wilderness, was declared out on Sunday (August 15) at noon. The fire started

as a result of a campfire and the investigation is continuing according to fire officials.

The fire was located near Lower Phyllis Lake approximately 20 miles northwest of Wisdom and

burned about a half-acre of timber before fire fighters brought it under control.

Currently no fire restrictions are in place across southwest Montana, but the fire danger is rated

as "high" which means vegetation is becoming very dry. With higher temperatures expected for the

next several days, forest users are asked to be extra careful and to make sure your campfire is dead

out before leaving the area.
