DILLON – The fourth meeting of a working group formed to look at the overall health of the Reservoir Creek Allotment near Dillon is scheduled for Friday, August 13, at the Dillon Field Office starting at 9 am. The working group was formed by the Western Montana Resource Advisory Council (RAC), an advisory committee for the Bureau of Land Management.

Interested members of the public are invited to listen to the proceedings. The goal of the group is to develop a plan to manage existing resource uses to achieve desired resource conditions. The subgroup will make recommendations to the Council at large, which, in turn, will make recommendations to BLM.
