# **Topic: Health Plan Administrator Invoices**

This issue communicates the basic health plan administrator (HPA) invoice information the HCTC program requires in order to process a payment.

## **Invoice Requirements**

In addition to an individual's base information (name, address, etc.) the following information should appear on your invoice to HCTC individuals:

- HPA name, address, and telephone number
- HPA payment remit address (if different than the default address above)
- Insurance product name
- · Total premium and premium due date
- A premium breakout between the major medical and excepted benefits premiums (See the August 1, 2003 Implementation document for details)
- One of the following: member ID, group ID, or policy number

Note: The HCTC program receives a copy of an HPA invoice directly from individuals during the HCTC registration process.

# **Invoice Timing**

If you are a state-qualified health plan, please be prepared to invoice new enrollees well in advance who:

- Participated in the advance pay in previous month(s), and
- Are nearing the end of their COBRA coverage period.

This action will mitigate interruption to an individual's monthly advance payment cycle.

## What Does This Mean For You?

Be prepared for inquiries from your HCTC members, if your HPA invoice does not include the required invoice information.

#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

Question: Must health plan administrators generate monthly invoices to HCTC participants?

**Answer:** No, HPAs do not need to generate monthly invoices to HCTC participants. HPAs can continue with their regular billing cycle.

Question: How often will HPAs receive payment from the HCTC program?

**Answer:** HCTC eligibility is determined monthly, therefore, premium payments from the HCTC program are made monthly.

**Question:** Can health plan administrators receive a copy of their invoice with the payment from the HCTC program?

**Answer:** No, since the HCTC program does not receive copies of each invoice, the HCTC program will not be able to supply a copy to the HPA.
