Changes to the Centralized Authorization File (CAF), third-party authorizations

CAF is a computerized system of records that contains information on authorized representatives of taxpayers. In July 2001, ten service center databases were consolidated into one database. Prior to July 2001, a stand-alone database existed at each service center. Effective January 2, 2002, all CAF processing is completed in only two Small Business/Self Employed Accounts Management Centers (Memphis and Ogden). These two centers will process all third-party authorization requests submitted on Forms 2848, 8821, and Form 706, Part 4. International CAF processing will remain in Philadelphia. The consolidation and centralized process provides easier access to third-party information, reduces processing problems, and simplifies procedures for obtaining authorization. Practitioners are no longer required to submit new authorization requests for each third-party correspondence on civil penalty issues. These changes allow the IRS to provide consistent customer service using one up-to-date database for customer inquiries, reducing unauthorized disclosures and improving timeliness and accuracy.
