Centralized Authorization File (CAF) Talking Points

Checkbox Authority

Effective January 2002:

- Employment Tax Returns Forms 94X
- Excise Tax Returns Forms 720 and 2290
- Railroad Retirement Returns Form CT-1

Checkbox authority allows paid preparers to deal with processing questions, refund/credit problems, or balance due issues. Limitations: Expires when return is processed and account is settled. It is superseded by Forms 2848 or 8821. **Oral Taxpayer Information Authority (TIA)**

Effective 2002. TIA allows taxpayers to call the IRS and provide the tax practitioner's CAF number to establish a TIA. The designee can immediately call to discuss issues. It can be compared to a paperless Form 8821, Tax Information Authorization.

Power Of Attorney (POA) Processing

Will be centralized in two centers, Memphis and Ogden, beginning January 2002. Civil Penalties Authorization

In March 2002, third-party authorizations for civil penalties will be recorded to CAF. This will eliminate the need to resubmit an authorization request each time a third party corresponds/calls on a civil penalty.
