Dear Community Leaders:

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) reorganized into a more customer-focused structure to better meet the needs of taxpayers. To help us accomplish our goal of becoming a top quality service organization, we believe that developing mutually beneficial relationships with organizations such as yours is vital to our success in delivering key messages and information to taxpayers. We are reaching out to members of religious and civic organizations and ask that you distribute the enclosed materials to your members.

On Wednesday, January 23, 2002, the IRS Commissioner, Charles Rossotti met with the leadership of the Congressional Black Caucus (CBC) to discuss actions to be taken by the Internal Revenue Service on several fronts to combat the recent upsurge of slavery reparation claims. In 2001, the agency received nearly 80,000 returns claiming more than \$2.7billion in false reparation refunds. The IRS will notify the taxpayer that the claim has no basis in law and provide them an opportunity to amend the return. Any returns filed after April 15th, 2002 could be subject to penalties. Therefore, we are urging you to share this information with your community.
