HIPAA Track

Although the first two major deadlines have passed, there are many challenges and opportunities for standardization still in Medicaid's future. Panels and presentations by CMS and NMEH members will start the planning for the technologies that we will need for upcoming HIPAA standards implementations.

Technology Track

States will participate in panels and give presentations on new technologies in their MMIS implementations. This track will also feature discussions on procurement strategies, multi-state or agency data sharing, best practices and other innovative technologies and processes.

MITA Track

CMS will be a giving a primer for understanding the architectural principles that will point MMIS' toward open platforms, interoperability, adaptability and flexibility. Case studies will feature "early adopter" state and CMS Regional Office staff presentations on APDs written with MITA in mind.

Vendor Track
