MEDLINEplus is designed to help you answer questions and make decisions about your health. This brochure will help you get started.

## **Getting started**


Begin your search by selecting "Health Topics" from the **MEDLINEplus** homepage. Then find your topic by clicking on an alphabet letter or on the other links on the Health Topics page. Health Topics are in both English and Spanish.

### **Drug Information**

Find practical information about a drug. Learn why and how a drug should be used Know when to contact a doctor and/or pharmacist and what to tell them. Not available in Spanish.

### **The Search Box**

Use the search box when you cannot find a **topic** page on your disease or condition Use the box also if you want to see all the **MEDLINEplus** information on your topic. Put a word or phrase in the box. Then click on the Search button or press the Enter key on your computer keyboard.

The Interactive Health Tutorials box links to a list of all tutorials available. Each tutorial explains a procedure or condition, and takes about 10 minutes to review You can also print the text of each tutorial. Tutorials are in both English and Spanish.
