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Glossary

Glossary

Area Agency on Aging (AAA): A public or private nonprofit organization designated by the state to develop and administer the area plan on aging within a sub-state geographic planning and service area. AAAs advocate on behalf of older people within the area and develop community-based plans for services to meet their needs. AAAs administer federal, state, local and private funds through contracts with local service providers.

American with Disabilities Act (ADA): A comprehensive Civil Rights law, which makes it unlawful to discriminate in private sector employment against a qualified individual with a disability. The ADA also outlaws discrimination against individuals with disabilities in state and local government services and employment, public accommodations, transportation, and telecommunications. The law was enacted in July of 1990. The private sector employment provisions (Title I) became effective for employers with 25 or more employees on July 26, 1992, and on July 26, 1994, for employers of 15 or more employees. The public sector employment provisions (Title II) became effective on January 26, 1992.

Accessible: Easy to approach, enter, operate, participate in, and/or use safely and with dignity by a person with a disability (e.g., site, facility, work environment, service, or program).

Administration on Aging (AoA): The AoA was established by the Older Americans Act of 1965. AoA is the principal federal agency responsible for programs authorized under that Act. AoA serves as an advocate for older persons at the national level, advises Congress and federal agencies on the characteristics and needs of older people, and develops programs designed to promote the health and well-being of the older population. AoA provides advice, funding, and assistance to achieve community-based systems of comprehensive social services for older people.

Beneficiary: A person who has health care insurance through the Medicare or Medicaid program.

Benefit Period: The way that Medicare measures your use of hospital and skilled nursing facility services. A benefit period begins the day you go to a hospital or skilled nursing facility. The benefit period ends when you have not received

hospital or skilled nursing care for 60 days in a row. If you go into the hospital after one benefit period has ended, a new benefit period begins. You must pay the inpatient hospital deductible for each benefit period. There is no limit to the number of benefit periods you can have.

Benefits: The money or services offered to a beneficiary by an insurance policy. In Medicare or a health plan, benefits take the form of health care.

Block Grant: A block grant is an intergovernmental transfer of federal funds to states and local governments for broad purposes such as health, education or community development in general. A block grant holds few requirements for how the money is to be spent, instead offering state and local discretion within general guidelines established by Congress and the executive branch. Annual program plans or applications are normally required.

Carrier: A private company that has a contract with Medicare to pay Medicare Part B bills.

Cash Surrender Value: The amount of cash a person may obtain by voluntarily surrendering a life insurance policy.

Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA) of 1985¹: Among other things, this law requires an employer to allow you to remain covered under the employer's group health plan for a certain length of time after losing your job, after reducing your work hours, after the death of your spouse, or after getting a divorce. You may have to pay both your share and the employer's share of the premium.

Copayment: In some Medicare health plans, this is the amount that you pay for each medical service received, like a doctor visit. In the Medicare program, a copayment is usually a set amount paid for a service, like \$5 or \$10 for a doctor visit.

Deductible: The amount you must pay for health care, before Medicare begins to pay. There is a deductible for each benefit period for Part A, and each year for Part B. Deductibles may change from year to year.

Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD): Established in 1965, HUD is the principal federal agency responsible for programs concerned with housing needs, fair housing opportunities, and improving and developing communities.

Dual Eligibles: The following describes the various categories of individuals who, collectively, are known as dual eligibles. Medicare has two basic coverage components: Part A, which pays for hospitalization costs; and Part B, which pays for physician services, laboratory and x-ray services, durable medical equipment, and outpatient and other services. Dual eligibles are individuals who are entitled to Medicare Part A and/or Part B and are eligible for some form of Medicaid benefit.

Earned Income: Money received from wages or earnings from self-employment.

Gross income means all income derived from whatever source, including funds from Social Security, wages or pensions. It is the income <u>before</u> deductions, such as Medicare Part B premiums or taxes, are taken out.

Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA): The federal agency within the Department of Health and Human Services that runs the Medicare, Medicaid, Clinical Laboratories (under CLIA program), and State Children's Health Insurance programs, and works to make sure that the beneficiaries in these programs are able to get high quality health care.

Health Maintenance Organization (HMO): A group of doctors, hospitals, and other health care providers who have agreed to provide care to Medicare beneficiaries in exchange for a fixed amount of money from Medicare every month. In an HMO, you usually must get all your care from providers that are part of the plan.

Medicaid: A joint Federal and State program that helps with medical costs for people with low incomes and limited resources. Medicaid programs vary from State to State, but most health care costs are covered if you qualify for both Medicare and Medicaid.

Medicaid Only Dual Eligibles (Non QMB, SLMB, QDWI, QI-1, or QI-2): These individuals are entitled to Medicare Part A and/or Part B and are eligible for full Medicaid benefits. They are not eligible for Medicaid as a QMB, SLMB, QDWI, QI-1, or QI-2. Typically, these individuals need to spend-down to qualify for Medicaid or fall into a Medicaid eligibility poverty group that exceeds the limits listed above. Medicaid provides full Medicaid benefits and pays for Medicaid services provided by Medicaid providers, but Medicaid will only pay for services also covered by Medicare if the Medicaid payment rate is higher than the amount paid by Medicare, and, within this limit, will only pay to the extent necessary to pay the beneficiary's Medicare cost-sharing liability. Payment by Medicaid of Medicaid services also covered by Medicare Part B premiums is a State option; however, States may not receive FFP for Medicaid services also covered under Medicare Part B had they been enrolled.

Medicare: The federal health insurance program for people 65 years of age or older, certain younger people with disabilities, and people with End-Stage Renal Disease (those with permanent kidney failure who need dialysis or a transplant, sometimes called ESRD). **Medicare Part A** provides coverage of inpatient hospital services, skilled nursing facilities, home health services and hospice care. **Medicare Part B** helps pay for the cost of physician services, outpatient hospital services, medical equipment and supplies and other health services and supplies.

Medicare+Choice: A new Medicare program that allows for more choices among Medicare health plans. Everyone who has Medicare Parts A and B is eligible, except those who have End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD).

Net income means income received by the beneficiary <u>after</u> deductions, such as Medicare Part B premiums or taxes, have been taken out.

Premium: A monthly payment for health care coverage to Medicare, an insurance company, or a health care plan.

Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB) without other Medicaid (QMB Only): These individuals are entitled to Medicare Part A, have income of 100 percent federal poverty level or less and resources that do not exceed twice the limit for SSI eligibility, and are not otherwise eligible for full Medicaid. Medicaid pays their Medicare Part A premiums, if any, Medicare Part B premiums, and, to the extent consistent with the Medicaid State plan, Medicare deductibles and coinsurance for Medicare services provided by Medicare providers. **QMB with full Medicaid (QMB Plus):** These individuals are entitled to Medicare Part A, have income of 100 percent federal poverty level or less and resources that do not exceed twice the limit for SSI eligibility, and are eligible for full Medicaid benefits. Medicaid pays their Medicare Part A premiums, if any, Medicare Part B premiums, and, to the extent consistent with the Medicaid State plan, Medicare deductibles and coinsurance, and provides full Medicaid benefits.

Qualified Disabled and Working Individual (QDWI): These individuals lost their Medicare Part A benefits due to their return to work. They are eligible to purchase Medicare Part A benefits, have income of 200 percent federal poverty level or less and resources that do not exceed twice the limit for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) eligibility, and are not otherwise eligible for Medicaid. Medicaid pays the Medicare Part A premiums only.

Qualifying Individual, Group 1 (QI-1): This group is effective 1/1/98 - 12/31/02. There is an annual cap on the amount of money available, which may limit the number of individuals in the group. These individuals are entitled to Medicare Part A, have income of at least 120 percent of the federal poverty level, but less than 135 percent the federal poverty level, resources that do not exceed twice the limit for SSI eligibility, and are not otherwise eligible for Medicaid. Medicaid pays their Medicare Part B premiums only.

Qualifying Individual, Group 2 (QI-2s): This group is effective 1/1/98-12/31/02. There is an annual cap on the amount of money available, which may limit the number of individuals in the group. These individuals are entitled to Medicare Part A, have income of at least 135 percent of the federal poverty level, but less than 175 percent of the federal poverty level, resources that do not exceed twice the limit for SSI eligibility, and are not otherwise eligible for Medicaid. Medicaid pays only a portion of their part B premiums (\$2.23 in 1999).

State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP): A State organization that receives money from the Federal Government to give health insurance counseling and assistance to Medicare beneficiaries at no cost.

Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiaries (SLMB): These individuals are entitled to Medicare Part A, have income of greater than 100 percent of the federal poverty level, but less than 120 percent of the federal poverty level and resources that do not exceed twice the limit for SSI eligibility, and are not otherwise eligible for Medicaid. Medicaid pays their Medicare Part B premiums only.

SLMB with full Medicaid (SLMB Plus): These individuals are entitled to Medicare Part A, have income of greater than 100 percent of the federal poverty level, but less than 120 percent of the federal poverty level and resources that do not exceed twice the limit for SSI eligibility, and are eligible for full Medicaid benefits. Medicaid pays their Medicare Part B premiums and provides full Medicaid benefits.
