Re: "Made in the USA"
Regulations

Gentlemen:

Please do not relax the
"made in the U.S. requirement,
particularly in regard to clothing.

After a nasty session with
a skin reaction to a shirt made
in Bangladesh, or Thailand, or some
outlandish place, my husband had
to go to the emergency room.
Every part of his body not covered
by his T-shirt was covered with
an itchy red rash. Even his upper
thighs where the shirttails hit were
affected. The doctor told him to
only buy shirts made in the U.S.A.
of 100% cotton, and even then
to wash before wearing. He
needed medication for weeks.

We filed a claim with the
sheet manufacturer and were
reimbursed for our out-of-pocket
expenses without question.

Fix finding sheets made in
the USA is proving to be quite
a challenge.

It is a sad commentary that
our country has sent so much
to foreign countries we cannot
buy or even find USA made
products.
