on Made in USA Label - Don't
Change

Dear Gentlemen:

Don't change the Made in the USA Label!
Allow only 100% made in the USA to
have the prestigious made in USA designation.

Because I want to support USA
workers and operators, I want to know

just "substantially completed" here. Anything
less would be conforming to me and
the rest of the forgotten bank and file
communities.

I want to buy more goods made
in the USA - not made in real China!
Too many goods are coming in from
foreign countries, and we are losing
our jobs and benefits to foreign meddling
in critical economic strategy - we
can't compete with those wages!

Don't mislabel goods we
buy from foreign countries - in the
past 10 years millions of full
time workers have been laid

jobs remaining.
