This Program Memorandum (PM) informs you that the OCE has been updated with new additions, changes, and deletions to Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System/Current Procedural Terminology, Fourth Edition (HCPCS/CPT-4) codes. CMS sent detailed information about these changes in separate communications. See PM AB-02-132. This OCE is used to process bills from Indian health services hospitals, critical access hospitals, Maryland hospitals, and hospitals located in American Samoa, Guam, and Saipan. Claims from Virgin Island hospitals with dates of service on or after January 1, 2002, are also processed through this OCE. Below are additional CMS changes that were not reflected in the separate communications sent.
