SUBJECT: Cease Further Work on the Eligibility File-Based Standard Trading Partner Agreement (STPA) for the Purpose of Coordination of Benefits (COB)

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: This instruction supersedes guidance provided to you in AB-03-066 and AB-02-095. Through these previous instructions, you were directed to not enter into new TPAs for the purpose of COB with non-insurer entities (also termed "trading partner business associates"). You were also notified to terminate your existing TPAs with these non-insurers entities and to convert your existing TPAs with appropriate entities over to the Eligibility File-Based STPA by September 30, 2003.
