"Other" exits include early terminations, transfers to another jurisdiction, modifications to intensive supervision probation, modifications to unsupervised probation, probation revocations or terminations, and other terminations (table 3.6).

"Misdemeanors" include an unknown number of probationers whose offense type is "Driving while intoxicated or under the influence of alcohol" (table 3.9).

The State reported having an electronic monitoring program but is unable to provide the number of probationers in that program on December 31, 1995 (table 3.10).

## **Arkansas**

Detailed data are not provided for entries, Hispanic origin, and probation status.

"Other" exits include administrative closures and discharged absconders (table 3.6).

"Incarcerated — under current sentence" include revoked probationers: "Other" exits include transfers, loss of jurisdiction, death, and an unknown/unspecified number of others (table 3.6).

#### Colorado

Colorado has 9 reporting agencies: 1 State and 8 local.

"Other" race includes 6,502 Hispanic probationers of unknown race (table 3.8).

## Connecticut

Detailed data are not provided for entries and exits.

Detailed data are estimated for sex, race, Hispanic origin, and intensive supervision.

Detailed data are not provided for entries, exits, offense type, and type of probation.

# **District of Columbia**

Data are not comparable to previous years because 1995 data include all programs (urban services, traffic and alcohol, diversion, civil protection orders, and fugitives).

Data are estimated for January 1 population, entries, exits, race, supervision status, intensive supervision, electronic monitoring, and boot camp programs.

Detailed data are not provided for entries, exits, and probation status.

"Other" exits include 1,136 probationers unsuccessfully terminated, 116 probationers "uncooperatively" terminated, 489 cases rendered nolle prosequi, and 109 unspecified or "other" probation terminations (table 3.6).

"Other" race includes 600 Hispanic probationers of unknown race (table 3.8)

"Felony" includes an unspecified number of felony DWI probationers. "Misdemeanor" includes an unspecified number of misdemeanor DWI/DUI probationers (table 3.9).

### **New Hampshire**

Detailed data are not provided for entries (table 3.5).

Detailed data are estimated for sex, race, Hispanic origin, offense type, status of probation, and supervision status.

## **New Jersey**

Detailed data are estimated for sex, race, Hispanic origin, and status of probation.

Data are not comparable to previous years because 1995 data include cases that are placed on probation for driving under the influence and motor vehicle community service participants (table 3.2). "Probation without incarceration" includes an unknown number of persons who entered probation by "Probation with incarceration;" "Other" entries include 12,772 pretrial interventions and conditional discharges, 8,954 community service cases, and 4,331 supervised collections (table 3.5).

"Other" exits include 4,695 absconders, 4,999 probation violations, 8,585 community service cases, and 7,357 other discharge (table 3.6).

"Other" race includes 16,811 Hispanic probationers of unknown race (table 3.8).

820 probationers are in a State intensive supervision program and 324 are in a county-based program (table 3.10).

#### **New Mexico**

"Incarcerated — with new sentence" includes an unspecified number of probationers released because they are "Incarcerated — under current sentence." "Other" exits include 869 unsatisfactory discharges, 364 special action cases, and 601 absconders (table 3.6).

# **New York**

"Other" types of status of probation include local conditional releases and cases with missing data (table 3.3).

"Other" entries include unknown cases and local conditional releases (table 3.5).

"Non-Hispanic origin" include an unknown number of probationers whose ethnicity is unknown (table 3.7).

"Other" offense types include interstate transfers, non-penal laws, and cases with missing data (table 3.9).

## **North Carolina**

Detailed data are estimated for supervision status (table 3. 4).

"Probation without incarceration" include an unknown number of persons who entered probation by "Probation with incarceration;" "Other" entries include adjustment residual (table 3.5).

"Incarcerated — under current sentence" include an unknown number of persons who are released from probation because they are "Incarcerated — with new sentence" (table 3.6).

Detailed data are not provided for Hispanic Origin (table 3.7).

"Other" race include probationers of unknown or unspecified race (table 3.8).

## North Dakota

"Suspended execution of sentence to incarceration" is estimated (table 3.3)

Detailed data are estimated for entries based on the current type of supervision profile (table 3.5).

#### Ohio

Ohio has 52 separate reporting agencies: 1 State and 51 local.

"Other" race includes 38 Hispanic probationers of unknown race (table 3.8).

#### Oklahoma

Oklahoma has 3 reporting agencies: 1 State and 2 local.

"Other" race includes 934 Hispanic probationers of unknown race (table 3.8).

## Oregon

Detailed data are estimated for status of probation (table 3.3).

"Other" types of status of probation include diversions and conditional discharges (table 3.3).

"Probation without incarceration" and "Probation with incarceration" are estimated (table 3.5).

"Other" entries include diversions and conditional discharges (table 3.5).

"Other" exits include discharged absconders, and bench probation (table 3.6).

"Other" race includes 2,691 Hispanic probationers of unknown race (table 3.8)

Intensive supervision programs and electronic monitoring programs include both probationers and parolees (table 3.10).

# Pennsylvania

Detailed data are estimated for exits, sex, race, Hispanic origin, offense type, status of probation, intensive supervision probation, and electronic monitoring.

Total exits are estimated (table 3.2).

"Other" entries include an unspecified number of probationers who were transferred and other unknown entries (table 3.5)

"Other" exits include 895 probationers who were transferred and 526 absconders (table 3.6).

"American Indian/Alaska Native" includes 942 probationers whose race is other than Black or White (table 3.8).

## **Rhode Island**

Detailed data are not provided for sex, race, Hispanic origin, offense type, and probation status.

The State reported having an intensive supervision program that began January 1, 1996; therefore, there are no probationers in this program in 1995 (table 3.10).

#### **South Carolina**

Detailed data are not provided for Hispanic origin.

"Other" types of status of supervision include offenders supervised by Federal immigration (table 3.4).

"Other" exits include probationers released for medical reasons (table 3.6).

"American Indian/Alaska Native" includes 305 probationers whose race is other than black or white (table 3.8).

"Other" offense type includes unclassified crimes (table 3.9).

## **South Dakota**

Data are reported for year beginning July 1, 1994 and ending June 30, 1995.

Data do not include 11 absconders.

Detailed data are not provided for entries, exits, sex, race, Hispanic origin, and status of probation.

"Misdemeanors" include an unspecified number of DWI/DUI cases (table 3.9).

## **Tennessee**

Tennessee has 3 reporting agencies: 1 State and 2 local.

Detailed data are not reported for the State's entries, exits, and probation status.

"Other" race includes 228 Hispanic probationers of unknown race (table 3.8).

#### **Texas**

Data are reported for year beginning September 1, 1994 and ending August 31, 1995. Data may slightly differ from previous years because data prior to 1995 represent calendar years.

Detailed data are not provided for entries and status of probation.

Detailed data are estimated for sex, race, and offense type based on sampling.

Detailed data for sex, race, Hispanic origin, and offense type exclude pretrial cases.

"Active" includes interstate transfers to the State (table 3.4).

Multiple entries are not counted (table 3.5).

"Incarcerated — under current sentence" include an unknown number of probationers who are released because they are "Incarcerated — with new sentence." "Other" exits include administrative closures and pretrial terminations; except for revocations, all exits represent individuals not cases (table 3.6).

"White" includes 146,953 Hispanic and other probationers of unknown race (table 3.8).

#### Utah

"Other" exits include 170 probationers whose probation is revoked and they are subsequently discharged, and 181 absconder status probationers whose probation is terminated (table 3.6).

#### Vermont

The number of probationers "of Hispanic origin" are estimated (table 3.7).

Detailed data are estimated for race (table 3.8).

# Virginia

All data are estimated.

Detailed data are not provided for probation status.

"Other" entries include an unspecified number of probationers who were restored to supervision, returned from other States, or transferred (table 3.5).

"Other" exits include an unspecified number of probationers who were released from probation because of revocation, warrant issued, out-of-State cases terminated, or transferred to another State (table 3.6).

# Washington

Washington has 24 separate reporting agencies: 1 State and 23 local.

"Other" races include 64 Hispanic probationers of unknown race (table 3.8).

# **West Virginia**

West Virginia has 2 reporting agencies: 1 State and 1 interstate compact agency. Interstate compact cases represent 3% of West Virginia's December 31, 1995, total. As reported, the interstate compact data are for year beginning July 1, 1994, and ending June 30, 1995.

No detailed data are provided.

The State's January 1 and December 31 populations are estimated (table 3.2).

The State's entries and exits are unknown (table 3.2, 3.5, 3.6).

#### Wisconsin

Detailed data are not provided for probation status (table 3.3).

"Active," "Absconder," and "Other" include 1,452 probationers who are supervised out-of-State (table 3.3).

"Probation with incarceration" include an unknown number of persons who entered probation by "probation without incarceration" (table 3.5).

"Incarcerated — with new sentence" include an unknown number of persons who are released from probation because they are "Incarcerated - under current sentence" (table 3.6).

Intensive supervision and electronic monitoring program numbers include both probationers and parolees (table 3.10).

# Wyoming

"Other" types of status of probation include reduction of sentence (table 3.3).

"Other" exits include 409 bench warrants (table 3.6).

"Other" race includes 261 Hispanic probationers of unknown race (table 3.8).

The State reported having an electronic monitoring program, but is unable to provide the number of probationers in the program (table 3.10).
