Re: Request for Approval of Applicant Pursuant to Federal Trade Commission Decision and Order Docket No. C-3933

Dear Mr. Burgon:

This letter responds to the April 11, 2000 application for approval ("Application") filed by TCH LLC ("TCH") requesting Federal Trade Commission ("Commission") approval of TCH as a New System Provider licensee. The Application was placed on the public record for thirty days, until May 17, 2000. No comments were received during the comment period. The Commission has considered TCH's Application and all supporting materials, as well as other available information, and has concluded that TCH has not demonstrated that it is a suitable licensee.

Under Paragraphs I.M. and II.B. of the Order, an applicant must be a "New System Provider" to qualify for a license. Based on materials submitted by TCH, TCH does not qualify as a New System Provider because its QuickTrans system has not operated in at least 25 fueling locations for a period not less than six months. Accordingly, the Commission has determined not to approve TCH's Application.
