Subj: LONG RANGE ACQUISITION ESTIMATES DATA UPDATE


United States Code Title 15, Section 637(A)(12)(C), requires the Department of the Navy (DoN) to prepare a forecast of expected contract opportunities for the next and succeeding fiscal years and make the forecast available to small businesses. We fulfill this requirement by publishing the Long Range Acquisition Estimates (LRAE) on the Acquisition Business Management web site and updating the information on an annual basis. The LRAE contains DoN requirements valued at \$100,000 or more that are forecasted for the next five fiscal years.

This year the update will again be done via the Internet. The ABM web site contractor, Dynamic Systems, has established a site for the update. This site contains instructions for performing the update, along with all of the current LRAE data. The update will cover fiscal years 2001 through 2005.

By July 15, 2000, please provide Mr. Rick Sullivan of Dynamic Systems, with the name, telephone number and e-mail address of your point of contact for this update. Each systems command is responsible for coordinating the input from the program executive officers and direct reporting program managers that it supports, which includes ensuring that the data are complete and the update is done on time.
