Yesterday the Federal Trade Commission announced that it has proposed that pornographic spam email would have to be clearly labeled with the label "Sexually-Explicit-Content." This proposal is due to take effect in mid-June.

Under this proposal, spammers would be required to include the words "Sexually-Explicit-Content" in the label of each email, enabling recipients the ability to block these emails. In addition, pornographers would not be allowed to include sexually explicit pictures in the body of the message.
