**JOINT MOTION FOR PROPOSED SCHEDULE**

Complaint counsel's last rebuttal witness will testify on Friday, March 22, 2002.

Complaint counsel, respondent Schering-Plough Corporation ("Schering"), and respondent Upsher-Smith Laboratories, Inc. ("Upsher") jointly propose, for the Court's consideration, closing the record on Tuesday, March 26.

Complaint counsel and respondents also jointly propose, for the Court's consideration, allowing until Thursday, April 18, for proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and post-trial briefs ("post-trial filings") and allowing until Monday, April 29, for reply post-trial filings.

Complaint counsel and respondents further jointly waive oral argument before the close of the record. We instead propose that oral argument be heard on May 1, two days after all post-trial filings have been submitted, or on whatever other date is convenient for the Court.

Based on the discussion above, complaint counsel and respondents respectively propose, for the Court's consideration, that this Court adopt the following schedule for the remainder of this matter:

- March 26, 2002: Close of the Record
- April 18, 2002: Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Briefs In Support Thereof due from all parties
- April 29, 2002: Reply Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Briefs In Support Thereof due from all parties
- May 1, 2002: Oral Argument


