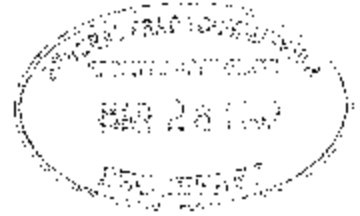

**ORDER CLOSING THE RECORD AND ON POST TRIAL BRIEFS**


