Name 3 rights or freedoms guaranteed by the Bill of Rights.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The right of freedom of speech, press, religion, peaceable assembly, and requesting change of government • The right to bear arms (the right to have weapons or own a gun, though subject to certain regulations) • The government may not quarter, or house, soldiers in the people's homes during peacetime without the people's consent • The government may not search or take a person's property without a warrant • A person may not be tried twice for the same crime and does not have to testify against him/herself • A person charged with a crime still has some rights, such as the right to a trial and to have a lawyer • The right to trial by jury in most cases • Protects people against excessive or unreasonable fines or cruel and unusual punishment • The people have rights other than those mentioned in the Constitution. • Any power not given to the federal government by the Constitution is a power of either the State or the people 	<p>75.
