TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER WITH ASSET FREEZE AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF

Plaintiff Federal Trade Commission ("Commission" or "FTC"), having filed its Complaint for a Permanent Injunction and Other Relief in this matter, pursuant to Section 13(b) of the Federal Trade Commission Act ("FTC Act"), 15 U.S.C. § 53(b), and having moved *ex parte* for a Temporary Restraining Order pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Fed. R. Civ. P. 65, and the Court having considered the Complaint, declarations, exhibits and memorandum of law filed in support thereof, and now being advised in the premises, finds that:

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of the case, and there is good cause to believe that the Court will have jurisdiction over the parties;

- 2. Venue properly lies with this Court;
- 3. There is good cause to believe that Defendants have engaged in and are likely to engage in acts and practices that violate Section 5(a) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a), and that the Commission is likely to prevail on the merits of this action;
- 4. There is good cause to believe that immediate and irreparable damage to the Court's ability to grant effective final relief for consumers in the form of monetary redress will occur from the sale, transfer, assignment, or other disposition or concealment by Defendants of their assets or records unless Defendants are immediately restrained and enjoined by Order of this Court;
- 5. There is good cause for issuing this Order pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(b) and for relieving the Plaintiff of the duty to provide Defendants with prior notice of the Plaintiff's motion;
- 6. Weighing the equities and considering the Plaintiff's likelihood of success, this Order is in the public interest; and
- 7. No security is required of any agency of the United States for issuance of a temporary restraining order. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(c).

DEFINITIONS

- 1. "Defendants" means Stuffingforcash.com Corp., American Publishing, Inc., Sound Publications, Inc., Nelson Barrero, Eduardo Gonzalez, and Ileana M. Morales, individually, and as officers of one or more of the above companies.
- 2. "Document" is synonymous in meaning and equal in scope to the term, as defined in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 34(a), and includes writings, drawings, graphs, charts, photographs, audio and video recordings, computer records, and other data compilations from which

information can be obtained and translated, if necessary, through detection devices into reasonably usable form. A draft or non-identical copy is a separate document within the meaning of this term.

- 3. "Asset" or "Assets" means any legal or equitable interest in, right to, or claim to, any real and/or personal property, including without limitation, chattels, goods, instruments, equipment, fixtures, general intangibles, leaseholds, mail or other deliveries, inventory, checks, notes, accounts, credits, contracts, receivables, shares of stock, and all cash, wherever located.
- 4. "Internet" means a worldwide system of linked computer networks that use a common protocol (TCP/IP) to deliver and receive information. The Internet includes but is not limited to the following forms of electronic communication: electronic mail and email mailing lists, the World Wide Web, Web sites, newsgroups, Internet Relay Chat, and file transfer protocols thereon, and remote computer access from anywhere in the world thereto.
- 5. "World Wide Web" (the "Web") means a system used on the Internet for cross-referencing and retrieving information. A "Web site" is a set of electronic documents, usually a home page and subordinate pages, readily viewable on a computer by anyone with access to the Web, standard software, and knowledge of the Web site's location or address.
- 6. "Material" means likely to affect a person's choice of, or conduct regarding, goods or services.
- 7. "Work-At-Home Opportunity" means any program, plan, product or service that enables a participant or purchaser to earn money by working at home.
- 8. "Person" means a natural person, an organization or other legal entity, including a corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, limited liability company, association, cooperative, or any other group or combination acting as an entity.
 - 9. "Plaintiff" means the Federal Trade Commission ("Commission").

I. PROHIBITED BUSINESS ACTIVITIES

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, in connection with the advertising, promotion, offering for sale, sale or provision of any goods or services, including but not limited to work-at-home opportunities, Defendants are hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from making or assisting in the making of, expressly or by implication, orally or in writing, any false or misleading statement or representation of material fact, including but not limited to the following:

- A. That Defendants will provide consumers with circulars for mailing and with preaddressed, pre-stamped envelopes to stuff;
- B. That Defendants will pay consumers money or other consideration for stuffing each individual envelope provided by Defendants;
- C. About the nature of any work-at-home opportunity, product, or service offered or sold;
- D. About any material term, condition, or limitation of the transaction or about the use of any offered good or service.

II. DISABLEMENT OF DEFENDANTS' WEB SITES

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pending determination of the Commission's request for a preliminary injunction, any party hosting any Web pages or Web sites for Defendants, including Yahoo! 701 First Avenue, Sunnyvale, California 94089, shall:

A. Immediately take whatever steps may be necessary to ensure that Web pages or Web sites operated, in whole or in part, under the names www.cashforstuffing.com, www.stuffingfordollars.com, www.stuffingfor

- B. Prevent the destruction or erasure of Web pages or Web sites operated, in whole or in part, under the names www.cashforstuffing.com, www.stuffingforcash.com, www.stuffingfordollars.com, www.stuffingfordollars.net and www.moneyforstuffing.com by preserving such Web pages or Web sites in the format in which they are currently maintained; and
- C. Immediately notify counsel for the FTC of any other Web page or Web site operated or controlled by Defendants.

III. ASSET FREEZE

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants, and their officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and all other persons or entities in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, are hereby restrained and enjoined from:

A. Transferring, converting, encumbering, selling, concealing, dissipating, disbursing, assigning, spending, withdrawing, or otherwise disposing of any funds, property, coins, precious metals, lists of consumer names, artwork, shares of stock, uncashed checks or other assets, wherever located, that are: (1) owned or controlled by Defendants, in whole or in part; (2) in the actual or constructive possession of Defendants; (3) held by an agent of Defendants as a retainer for the agent's provision of services to Defendants; or (4) owned, controlled by, or in the actual or constructive possession of, or otherwise held for the benefit of, any corporation, partnership or other entity directly or indirectly owned, managed, or controlled by Defendants, including, but not limited to, any assets held by or for Defendants in any account at any bank or savings and loan institution, credit card processing agent or with any broker-dealer, escrow agent, title company, commodity

trading company, precious metal dealer, or other financial institution of any kind, including, but not limited to, assets at:

Terrabank, N.A.

Amsouth Bank

Fifth Third Bank

Discover

American Express

- B. Opening or causing to be opened any safe deposit boxes or commercial mail boxes titled in the name of any Defendant, or subject to access by any Defendant;
- C. Incurring charges or cash advances on any credit or debit card issues in the name, singly or jointly, of any Defendant or any corporation, partnership or other entity directly or indirectly owned, managed or controlled by any Defendant; or
- D. Securing a loan with or incurring a lien on real property, personal property, or other asset held in the name, singly or jointly, of any Defendant.

The assets affected by this Section shall include both existing assets and assets acquired after the effective date of this Order, including, without limitation, those acquired by loan or gift, and assets in the form of retainers paid to Defendants' agents as compensation for the provision of services to Defendants. Defendants, or any third party holding assets for the benefit of Defendants, shall hold all assets, including without limitation, payments, loans, and gifts, received after service of this Order. Notwithstanding the asset freeze provisions of Section III.A - D above, Defendants

may pay reasonable, usual, ordinary, and necessary living expenses, and reasonable attorneys fees, after obtaining prior written approval by the Commission or by the Court.

IV. DUTIES OF ASSET HOLDERS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any financial or brokerage institution, business entity or person having possession, custody or control of any records of any Defendant, or of any account, safe deposit box, or other asset titled in the name of any Defendant, either individually or jointly, or held for the benefit of any Defendant, or that has maintained any such account, safe deposit box, or other asset at any time since January 1, 1999, shall:

- A. Hold and retain within its control and prohibit the transfer, encumbrance, pledge, assignment, removal, withdrawal, dissipation, sale or other disposal of any such account or other asset, except for transfers or withdrawals directed by further order of this Court;
- B. Deny any person or entity access to any safe deposit box titled individually or jointly in the name of any Defendant or otherwise held for the benefit of or subject to access by any Defendant;
- C. Provide to counsel for the Plaintiff, within five (5) business days of notice of this Order, a sworn statement setting forth:
 - The identification of each account or asset titled in the name, individually or
 jointly, of any Defendant, or held on behalf of, or for the benefit of, any
 Defendant;
 - 2. The balance of each account or a description of the nature and value of each asset as of the close of business on the day this Order is served, and, if the account or asset has been closed or moved, the date closed or removed, the

- total funds removed in order to close the account, and the person or entity to whom such account or other asset was remitted; and
- 3. The identification of any safe deposit box or storage facility that is either titled in the name of or subject to access by any Defendant.
- D. The Commission is granted leave, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 45, to subpoena documents immediately from any such financial institution, account custodian or other aforementioned entity concerning the nature, location, status and extent of Defendants' assets, and compliance with this Order.

For the purposes of this Section, the Commission may properly serve this Order on any financial or brokerage institution, business entity or person that holds, controls or maintains custody of any account or asset of any Defendant or has held, controlled or maintained custody of any account or asset of any Defendant at any time since January 1, 1999, by facsimile transmission, hand delivery or overnight carrier.

V. REPATRIATION OF FOREIGN ASSETS AND DOCUMENTS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, within five (5) business days following service of this Order, Defendants shall:

- A. repatriate to the United States all funds, documents or assets in foreign countries held either: (1) by any Defendant; (2) for the benefit of any Defendant; or (3) under the direct or indirect control, jointly or singly, of any Defendant;
- B. the same business day as any repatriation under Section V.A. above, (1) notify counsel for the Commission of the name and location of the financial institution or other entity that

is the recipient of such funds, documents or assets; and (2) serve this Order on any such financial institution or other entity;

- C. provide the Commission with a full accounting of all funds, documents, and assets outside of the territory of the United States held either: (1) by any Defendant; (2) for their benefit; or (3) under their direct or indirect control, jointly or singly;
- D. hold and retain all repatriated funds, documents and assets and prevent any transfer, disposition or dissipation whatsoever of any such assets or funds; and
- E. Provide the Commission with access to all records of accounts or assets of the Defendants held by financial institutions located outside the territorial United States by signing the Consent to Release of Financial Records attached to this Order as **Attachment A**.

VI. INTERFERENCE WITH REPATRIATION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants are hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from taking any action, directly or indirectly, which may result in the encumbrance or dissipation of foreign assets, or in the hindrance of the repatriation required by the preceding Section of this Order, including but not limited to:

- A. Sending any statement, letter, fax, e-mail or wire transmission, or telephoning or engaging in any other act, directly or indirectly, that results in a determination by a foreign trustee or other entity that a "duress" event has occurred under the terms of a foreign trust agreement, until such time that all assets have been fully repatriated pursuant to the preceding Section of this Order; and
- B. Notifying any trustee, protector or other agent of any foreign trust or other related entities of either the existence of this Order, or of the fact that repatriation is required pursuant to a

Court Order, until such time as all assets have been fully repatriated pursuant to the preceding Section of this Order.

VII. RECORD KEEPING/MAINTAINING BUSINESS RECORDS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants are each hereby restrained and enjoined from:

- A. Failing to make and keep books, records, accounts, bank statements, current accountants' reports, general ledgers, general journals, cash receipts ledgers, cash disbursements ledgers and source documents, documents indicating title to real or personal property, and any other data which, in reasonable detail, accurately and fairly reflect the transactions and dispositions of the assets of Defendants; and
- B. Destroying, mutilating, concealing, altering, transferring, or otherwise disposing of, in any manner, any books, records, tapes, discs, accounting data, checks (fronts and backs), correspondence, forms, advertisements, brochures, manuals, electronically stored data, banking records, customer lists, customer files, invoices, telephone records, ledgers, payroll records, or other documents of any kind, including information stored in computer-maintained form, in their possession, custody, or control.

VIII. <u>DISTRIBUTION OF ORDER BY DEFENDANTS</u>

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants shall immediately provide a copy of this Order to each affiliate, partner, division, sales entity, successor, assign, officer, director, employee, independent contractor, Web master, agent, attorney, and/or representative of any Defendant and shall, within ten (10) days from the date of entry of this Order, serve upon counsel for the

Commission a sworn statement that they have complied with this provision of this Order, which statement shall include the names and addresses of each such person or entity who has received a copy of the Order.

IX. SERVICE OF ORDER

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that copies of this Order may be served by any means, including facsimile transmission, upon any financial institution or other entity or person that may have possession, custody, or control of any documents or assets of any Defendant, or that may be subject to any provision of this Order. Service upon any branch or office of any financial institution or entity shall effect service upon the entire financial institution or entity.

Plaintiff's agents or employees may serve this Order upon any Defendant or other person that may be subject to any provision of this Order by serving a copy personally or by first class mail, overnight delivery, facsimile or electronic mail.

X. CREDIT REPORTS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Commission may obtain credit reports concerning Defendants pursuant to Section 604(a)(1) of the Fair Credit Reporting Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1681b(a)(1), and that upon written request, any credit reporting agency from which such reports are requested shall provide them to Plaintiff Commission.

XI. FINANCIAL REPORTS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants shall each, within five (5) business days after service of this Order, prepare and provide to counsel for the Commission:

- A. A completed financial statement accurate as of the date of service of this Order upon Defendants (Defendants Nelson Barrero, Eduardo Gonzalez and Ileana M. Morales shall include all financial information as requested by the Federal Trade Commission's Financial Statement of Individual Defendant, appended hereto as **Attachment B**; Defendants Stuffingforcash.com Corp., American Publishing, Inc. and Sound Publications, Inc. shall include all financial information requested by the Federal Trade Commission's Financial Statement of Corporate Defendant, appended hereto as **Attachment C**). The Financial Statements shall be accurate as of the date of the entry of this Order and shall be verified under oath;
- B. A complete and accurate list of Defendants' customers including, if available, the customers' name, address, email address, date of purchase of Defendants' services, and the amount the customer paid Defendants.

XII. EXPEDITED DISCOVERY

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, notwithstanding the provisions of Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 26(d) and (f) and 30(a)(2)(C), and pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 30(a), 34, and 45, the parties are granted leave, at any time after service of this Order, to:

A. Take the deposition, on three (3) days' notice, of any person, whether or not a party, for the purpose of discovering the nature, location, status, and extent of the assets of the Defendants, or their affiliates or subsidiaries; the nature and location of documents reflecting the Defendants' business transactions, or the business transactions of the Defendants' affiliates or subsidiaries; the location of any premises where Defendants, directly or through any third party, conduct business operations; the Defendants' whereabouts; and/or the applicability of any evidentiary privileges to this action. The limitations and conditions set forth in Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(a)(2)(B) and 31(a)(2)(B)

regarding subsequent depositions of an individual shall not apply to depositions taken pursuant to this Section. Any such depositions taken pursuant to this Section shall not be counted toward the ten (10) deposition limit set forth in Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(a)(2)(A) and 31(a)(2)(A). Service of discovery upon a party, taken pursuant to this Section, shall be sufficient if made by facsimile or by overnight delivery; and

B. Demand the production of documents, on five (5) days' notice, from any person, whether or not a party, relating to the nature, status, or extent of Defendants' assets, or of their affiliates or subsidiaries; the location of documents reflecting the business transactions of Defendants, or of their affiliates or subsidiaries; the location of any premises where Defendants, directly or through any third party, conduct business operations; the Defendants' whereabouts; and/or the applicability of any evidentiary privileges to this action, provided that twenty four (24) hours' notice shall be deemed sufficient for the production of any such documents that are maintained or stored only as electronic data.

XIII. IMMEDIATE ACCESS TO DEFENDANTS' BUSINESS PREMISES

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants, and each of them, and any other person served with a copy of this Order, shall allow the Commission's employees, representatives, agents and assistants immediate access to the business premises, storage facilities and all other business locations at which Defendants regularly conduct business or store their records, including, but not limited to, the offices at 4300 N University Drive, D-206, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33351. This right of access shall extend to any and all business premises and storage facilities owned, controlled or used by any of the Defendants (even if other business entities also share such premises or facilities),

shall continue from day to day, and shall include access to the entire premises for the purpose of inspecting, indexing and copying:

- A. documents evidencing, referring, or relating to the advertising, marketing, of offering of work-at-home opportunities, including documents pertaining to any business relationship between Defendants and other business entities;
- B. documents evidencing, referring, or relating to Defendants' financial status, including, but not limited to, the nature or location of any bank account, safe deposit box, or other asset of any Defendant;
- C. documents evidencing, referring, or relating to any correspondence, transaction, or other communication by or between any consumer or prospective consumer and any Defendant or any of Defendants' representatives, employees, agents, officers, servants, or assistants; and
- D. documents evidencing, referring, or relating to any correspondence, action or other communication by or between any law enforcement agency, consumer group, or Better Business Bureau and any Defendant or any of Defendants' representatives, employees, agents, officers, servants or assistants.

Defendants shall provide Commission employees, agents and assistants with any necessary means of access to these documents, including, without limitation, keys and combinations to locks, computer access codes, and storage access information. Defendants, their agents, employees, salespersons, accountants and attorneys are hereby enjoined and restrained from interfering in any way with the Commission's right of access described herein. The Commission's representatives may remove original documents from Defendants' business premises for the purpose of making photocopies, provided that the originals are returned to Defendants within a reasonable period of time.

XIV. WITHHOLDING OF MAIL SENT TO COMMERCIAL MAIL RECEIVING AGENCIES

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all Commercial Mail Receiving Agencies ("CMRA") where Defendants maintain accounts, including those at 28 E. Jackson, 10th Floor C-1006, Chicago, IL 60604 and 666 5th Ave #4, New York, NY 10103, shall, for the duration of this Order, retain and forward to Plaintiff, at the address designated in Section XVII below, all mail received at the CMRA that is addressed to any corporate Defendant, including Stuffingforcash.com Corp., American Publishing Incorporated, and Sound Publications Incorporated, and/or addressed to any other name under which the Defendants are doing business, including "Cash for Stuffing," "Stuffing for Cash," "Money for Stuffing," "Stuffing for Money," "Stuffing for Dollars," and "Dollars for Stuffing."

XV. WRIT OF ASSISTANCE BY UNITED STATES POSTAL INSPECTORS AND OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that United States Postal Inspectors and other law enforcement personnel may aid and assist the Commission in serving the Court's Order on Defendants and may further enforce this Order.

XVI. ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE REGARDING PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(b), that the Defendants shall appear before this Court, on the floor of the Dirksen Federal Courthouse, 219 S. Dearborn, Chicago, Illinois, on the day of JWLY, 2002, at floor of the Dirksen Federal Courthouse, o'clock m., to show cause, if there is any, why this Court should not enter a preliminary injunction, pending final ruling on the Complaint against Defendants, enjoining them from further violations of Section 5(a) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a), continuing the freeze of their assets and imposing such additional relief as may be appropriate.

Defendants shall serve answering pleadings or materials on counsel for the Commission not less than // business days prior to the hearing on the Commission's request for a preliminary injunction. Plaintiff may submit reply pleadings or materials by // DAYS THEKE AFTE / ...

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Temporary Restraining Order granted herein shall expire on at 10.00 a.m., on 2002, unless, for good cause shown, the Temporary Restraining Order is extended, or unless, as to any Defendant, the Defendant consents that it should be extended for a longer period of time.

XIX. RETENTION OF JURISDICTION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over this matter for

all purposes.
