Page 3 - Replace Section 3.c.(2)(a)

(a) Total project cost is less than \$2,500 - The Assistant Director for E/WFO may, through delegation of his/her authority, designate the appropriate staff within the E/WFO organization to recommend, concur and approve the briefing paper; however, in no event will the delegation for approval go below the branch chief level.

Page 3 - Replace Section 3.c.(2)(b)

(b) Total project cost of \$2,500 or greater and less than \$100,000 (including amendments for project cost increases) - The Assistant Director for E/WFO may, through delegation of his/her authority, designate the appropriate staff within the E/WFO organization to recommend, concur and approve the briefing paper; however, in no event will the delegation for approval go below the division chief level.

Page 3 - Replace Section 3.c.(2)(c)

(c) Total project cost of \$100,000 or greater and less than \$1,000,000 (including amendments for project cost increases) - The Assistant Director for E/WFO may, through delegation of his/her authority, designate the appropriate staff within the E/WFO organization to recommend and concur with the briefing paper; and the Assistant Director for E/WFO will approve.

Page 3 - Replace Section 3.c.(2)(d)

(d) Total project cost of \$1,000,000 or greater (including amendments for project cost increases) - The Assistant Director for E/WFO will recommend; the Deputy Director for Operations and Technical Services and the Director of OSMRE will concur; and the Assistant Secretary for Land and Minerals Management will approve.
