Directive AML-19, Transmittal Number 643, dated November 5, 1990, is changed in paragraph 4.c.(2)(b) shown below. The purpose of the change is to ensure that the prior-year carryover amounts available for State/Tribal Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation, as reported in the summary table of available grant funds included in the subject obligations report, are in agreement with the prior-year carryover amounts reported by the Division of Financial Management.

Paragraph 4.c.(2)(b) is revised as follows:

(b) This information will be provided to the Chief, DAMLR/HQ, via Lotus 1-2-3 spreadsheets within 15 working days following the last day of each semi-annual period. The Lotus files must be in non-WYSIWYG format in order to be compatible with each other and with the automated spreadsheet file maintained by DAMLR/HQ. Included in the Lotus files will be a column for grant funds that have been deobligated but not yet suballotted as of the end of each reporting period. Spreadsheets with identical data formats are to be utilized by ESC/WSC. Both ESC/WSC develop such Lotus files which conform in format (same cell addresses) in order to facilitate the combining of both files by DAMLR/HQ.
