NOTICE OF RESCISSION

In response to Executive Order 12861 "Elimination of one-half of executive branch internal regulations," a review of the OSM directives was conducted. As a result, the directives listed below are rescinded because either the directive is obsolete and no longer needed, or adequate guidance exists in laws, regulations, or OSM and Departmental guidance. As with other recissions, these changes do not affect any requirements of law. Presentation of credentials, for example, is a regulatory requirement, since the equivalent is stated in the regulation, it is not necessary to repeat it in a directive.
