The Office of Surface Mining (OSM) just completed its oversight report entitled, An Evaluation of Approximate Original Contour and Postmining Land Uses in Virginia. We released a draft report in June 1999 and requested public comment. The public comment period closed July 2, 1999.

We received comments from three governmental agencies, one special interest group, and one individual.
