**SUBJECT: Installation of Version 33.0 of the Provider Statistical and Reimbursement (PS&R) Reporting System-Modification of CR 3131**

## I. GENERAL INFORMATION

**A. Background:** The PS&R system supports fiscal intermediaries (FIs) and healthcare providers by accumulating and reporting the statistical and reimbursement data needed to conduct settlement and audit processes. The PS&R system summarizes claims processing activities and payments made to participating Medicare providers by FIs for all Medicare covered services. FIs running the PS&R on a daily basis shall implement Version 33 no later than August 1, 2004, while FIs that run claims data through the PS&R on a monthly basis shall use Version 33 for all claims with payment dates beginning August 1, 2004.

**B. Policy:** The PS&R system is updated to reflect recent changes in the reimbursement of covered Medicare services, and will continue to be updated to reflect changes in the payment of claims or the collection of data to satisfy Medicare cost report requirements.
