**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Year (FY) 2005 Payment for Services Furnished in Ambulatory Surgical Centers (ASCs)

#### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

#### A. Background:

Section 626(a) of the MMA mandates a 0 percent increase for inflation in fiscal year 2005, the last quarter of calendar year 2005, and each calendar year from 2006 through 2009. Until CMS has had an opportunity to determine the impact of changes in the fiscal year 2005 inpatient hospital wage index on payment amounts for individual ASCs, implementation of new wage index values for fiscal year 2005 is deferred. Therefore, for services furnished on or after October 1, 2004, payments to ASCs will not change. Carriers shall continue to use the FY 2004 wage index to calculate payments to ASCs and the payment rates that were effective for services furnished on or after April 1, 2004 (Change Request #3082 dated 2/6/2004) until further notice.

Carriers use the inpatient hospital wage index to adjust the labor-related portion of national ASC payment rates for geographic wage differences. The labor-related portion of ASC payment rates is defined currently as 34.45 percent of the payment rate. Carriers shall continue to using the FY 2004 hospital inpatient wage index to calculate payments for ASC services.

#### B. Policy:

Transmittal AB-03-116 (CR 2871), issued August 8, 2003, updated ASC facility payment rates for inflation and updated the wage index values used to adjust ASC payments for geographic wage differences effective for services furnished on or after October 1, 2003.

Transmittal 51 (CR 3082), issued February 4, 2004, notified contractors about a change in ASC payment rates effective April 1, 2004, resulting from enactment of section 626(a) of the Medicare Prescription Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act of 2003 (MMA).

ASC payment rates for fiscal year 2005 will remain as follows:

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Group 1- $333 Group 5 - $717

Group 2- $446 Group 6 - $826 ($676 + $150 for intraocular lenses (IOLs))

Group 3- $510 Group 7 - $995

Group 4- $630 Group 8 - $973 ($823 + $150 for IOLs)

Group 9 - $1339
